I'm just getting through my first winter here and there are a few things slipping through my grasp. First, I have forgotten to seal up the exhaust fans located in front of, and behind, the altar. Those large grates are wonderful in the summer but very cold in the winter. We lose a great deal of heat because of this. As the kids would say: "My bad, on that!" Also, the temperature will be raised in church. Again, my fault. I've used these words before, quoting Dick Vermeil when he first took over the Eagles: "There were a lot of things that they didn't tell me when I took this job..."☺**

**The past few Saturdays I have spent considerable time in our gym doing the PA announcing for the CYO basketball games. It has given me a new perspective on things and people. I have met many new folks from the different parishes who bring their teams to the games. I have met many new coaches, players, families, and officials. I have even spoken to some of the folks from St. Anselm. Thanks to all who work behind the scenes and operate the concession stand. The water and pretzels are wonderful!**

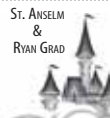

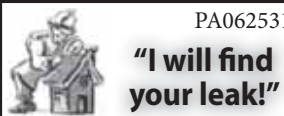
