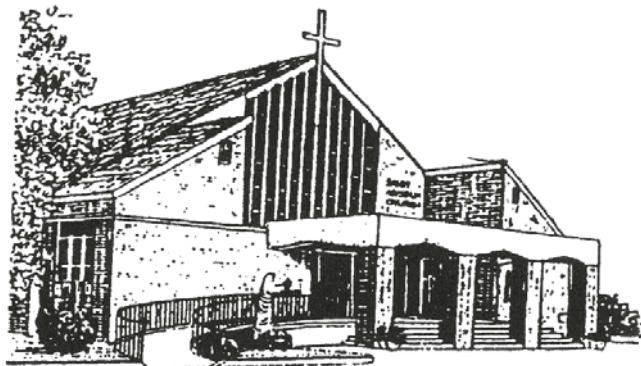

A final October Autumnal Greeting to all:

One more time for my favorite word, “autumnal.” Although I always talk about the cooling temperatures and times of the autumn season, it seems that this year summer does not want to let go. Similar events take place in our own spiritual lives. Just when we think that we have “things taken care of,” the unexpected happens. While we should never fear the future, or think that we are unprepared spiritually, we should realize that we always need the loving presence of God in our lives. When things don’t go as planned, it’s reassuring that God is at our side. A line from the “Sound of Music:” “When life closes a door; God opens a window!”

The month of October is devoted to Our Blessed Mother, through The Holy Rosary. A bit of a reflection:

The rosary probably began as a practice by the laity to imitate the monastic Divine Office (Breviary or Liturgy of the Hours), during the course of which the monks daily prayed the 150 Psalms. The laity, many of whom could not read, substituted 50, or even 150, Ave Marias (Hail Marys) for the Psalms. Sometimes a cord with knots on it was used to keep an accurate count of the Aves.

Rosary means a *crown of roses*, a spiritual bouquet given to the Blessed Mother. It is sometimes called the Dominican Rosary, to distinguish it from other rosary-like prayers (e.g. the Franciscan Rosary of the Seven Joys or Franciscan Crown, the Servite Rosary of the Seven Sorrows). It is also, in a general sense, a form of chaplet or corona (crown), of which there are many varieties in the Church. Finally, in English it has been called "Our Lady's Psalter" or "the beads." This last derives from an Old English word for prayers (bede) and to request.

A few things to catch-up on... On Thursday, October 19, we were blessed to welcome to our St. Anselm Parish and School Communities, a successor of the apostles, Most Reverend John McIntyre. Bishop McIntyre conferred the Sacrament of Confirmation to 60 of our school and CCD students. With their families, friends and classmates there, our Confirmandi received the Gifts of the Holy Spirit, as they were incorporated fully into the Catholic Faith. Thank you to Mrs. Murphy, Mr. Polselli, Mrs. Lopez, Mrs. Leonetti, Mrs. Granroth, Mr. Stepnowski, Nicole Pryor, Thomas DiMarcantonio, Erin O’Brien, Carli Squares, Bernadette Cartin, Belinda Gerz, Toni Bird and Charmaine Murray. Thanks, also, to the parents and families of our 2017 Confirmation Class.

On Saturday, October 21, St. Anselm Parish held our 2nd annual “Classic Car Show.” Under the direction of Denise Gentile - and her faithful group of volunteers - the Northeast Philadelphia Muscle Car Club provided over 80 vintage and classic cars to be observed. On a sun-splashed late morning and afternoon, the St. Anselm parking lot was transformed into a meeting place filled with music, food, vendors, and spectators who came to see many of the vehicles from their youth. Myself, included! ☺ Thank you, once again, to all of our volunteers who cover everything from decorations to food, to counting the proceeds. It was truly a wonderful day in every way, especially reflective of our St. Anselm spirit of diversity and ingenuity.

Over the span of two days, both our high school and grade school CYO experienced their annual “hay rides.” On crisp-like evenings, our students were treated to the yearly tradition of gathering with their friends and school mates in the Fall rituals. Thank you to Fr. Cavara and to our many good and devoted parents and chaperones who travelled with our young folks, to insure a good time.

Finally, a thank you to all who gathered to pray the rosary to Our Blessed Mother in our Prayer Garden on Friday, October 13. Coinciding with the 100th Anniversary of the Apparitions of Our Lady of Fatima, this devoted group observed the anniversary by giving praise and devotion to Our Blessed Lady. Our Lady of the Rosary; Our Lady of Fatima, pray for us.
