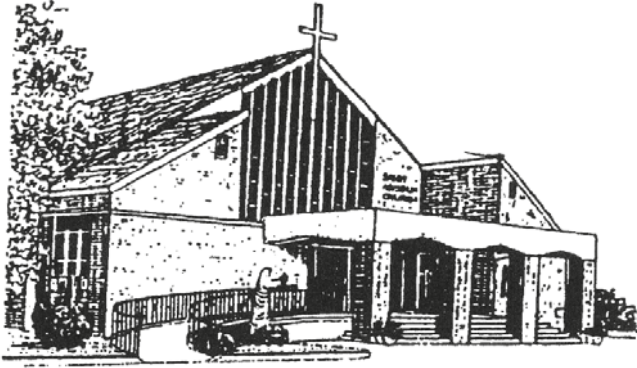

This Fuel Assistance Program is available to people of all ages within the income guidelines. For example, individuals with a monthly income less than \$1,485, or a two-person household with a monthly income under \$2,002, qualify for the grant. Call United Social Services at 215-923-1900 Monday thru Friday between 10 AM and 4 PM. A staff worker will explain the eligibility requirements, answer your questions and assist you in completing an application. This grant is provided to all who qualify and does not have to be repaid. All inquiries are confidential.

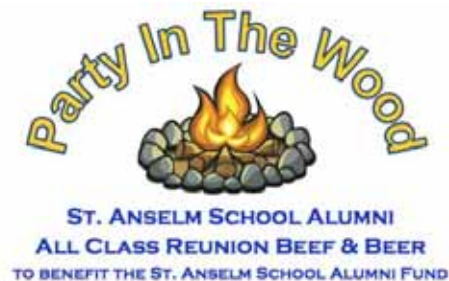

In a recent email, Diana DiMarcantonio reports...

I can't thank (the people of) St. Anselm school and parish enough for their generous donations. We were able to touch the lives of so many. We saw and treated 1,034 villagers in Maonde. We gave baby clothes and supplies to 50 soon-to-be-moms, educated them on prenatal care and brought the technology to allow them to hear their baby's heartbeat for the first time. We were able to supply 75 young girls with hygiene products. We donated clothes, bags, food parcels and hygiene products to the care workers and volunteers who live in the community who help the more vulnerable. We also had the opportunity to pray with the villagers in their church, in their homes and in their schools.

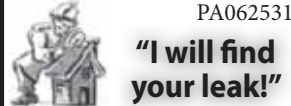
