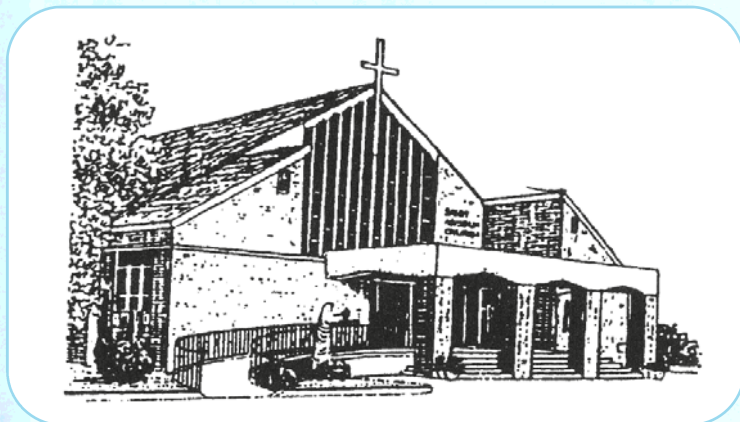

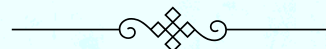

A celebratory “Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe” greeting to all:

The feast of “Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe,” marks the end of our Catholic liturgical year. A “brief” explanation:

**The Liturgical year is made up of six seasons:**

**Advent** - four weeks of preparation before the celebration of Jesus' birth.

**Christmas** - recalling the Nativity of Jesus Christ and his manifestation to the peoples of the world.

**Lent** - a six-week period of penance before Easter.

**Sacred Paschal Triduum** - the holiest "Three Days" of the Church's year, where the Christian people recall the suffering, death, and resurrection of Jesus.

**Easter** - 50 days of joyful celebration of the Lord's resurrection from the dead and his sending forth of the Holy Spirit.

**Ordinary Time** - divided into two sections (one span of 4-8 weeks after Christmas Time and another lasting about six months after Easter Time), wherein the faithful consider the fullness of Jesus' teachings & works among his people.

## PROPERTY TAX REBATE

To help with the rising cost of living, you are reminded that Pennsylvania Property Tax/Rent Rebate Program applications are now available. There are new guidelines which will permit individuals that qualify to receive rebate between \$250 and \$650 from property taxes or rent paid last year. Funding for this rebate program is made possible by the Pennsylvania State Lottery Fund and is a rebate that does not have to be repaid. This application must be filed by December 31, 2017.

To qualify, you must be 65 years of age or older, a widow or widower 50 years of age or older, or a disabled person 18 years or older. Homeowners that have annual incomes of \$36,600 or less and renters with annual incomes of \$15,700 or less could qualify. Only half of your annual Social Security or SSI income is counted toward the income guideline.

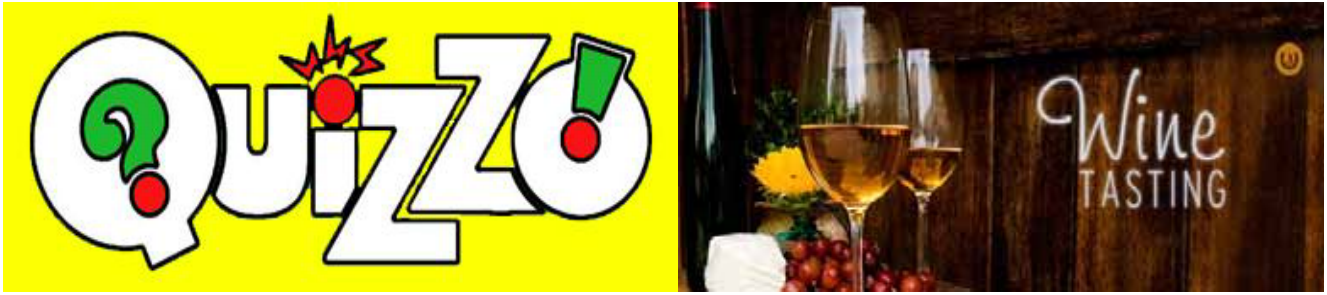

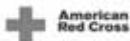
