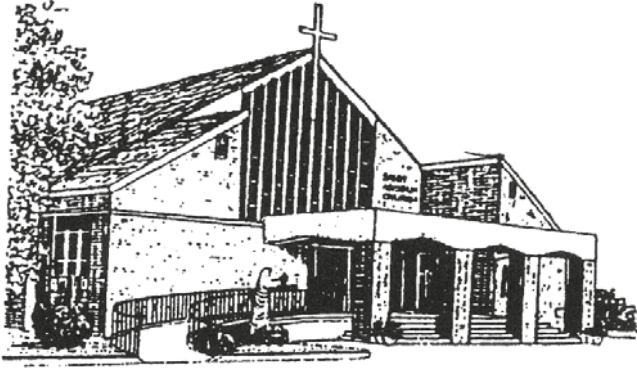

The Holy Season of Advent

"Come, Lord, come Lord Jesus, bring your people peace . . . hope . . . joy. . . life." This prayer, expressed in an Advent hymn titled "Maranatha", captures the desire we need to bring to life in our hearts and souls at this time of year.

December is a busy time for many people. However, our preparations for Christmas must also include a spiritual preparation. We will do our best here to make the weekend Masses in Advent prayerful, reflective, and meditative. I hope that you will more fully enter into the spirit of our Advent Eucharistic celebration so that your presence here will be the quality time you need to spiritually prepare for Christmas.

A Spiritually for Advent: Darkness and Light

At Christmas we celebrate Jesus Christ as the true Light of the World. Many years ago, the Church decided to celebrate Christmas during the Winter Solstice in the Northern Hemisphere when the earth grows dark and cold.

Since Christmas celebrates Jesus as the Light, the focus of Advent can be on darkness. At this time of year, the evening stars come upon us quickly and we are wrapped in winter's coldness all too suddenly. We find ourselves seeking light and warmth not just for our bodies but also for our minds and hearts, which are so often dulled and burdened with the wearing events of everyday life.

The physical darkness of winter can be used as a symbol of the darkness that touches our lives. Evil, sin, violence, addiction, sorrow, depression, hurts, etc. can be viewed as forms of darkness. The presence or nearness of these realities can displace the light of love, peace and joy in us.

Throughout Advent, in your prayers, ask God to help you to identify the forces of darkness that touch your life. Lift this up to God in prayer with Advent hope that Jesus comes to rescue and save you from the powers of darkness.

The Little Blue Book

The Little Blue Book is available for your Advent Prayer. In *The Little Blue Book*, there is a reflection for each day of Advent. The season of Advent can be a busy, hectic time as we prepare for Christmas. The prayerful reflections in *The Little Blue Book* offer a period of quiet and calm to foster the true spirit of Christmas within us. The Book is so little that you can carry it in your pocket or pocketbook.

There is an Advent spirit in the heart of every human person. It is one of longing, of yearning for a fulfillment that somehow lies beyond ourselves; for we long for the coming of the Lord.

As you put your gift in the St. Vincent DePaul Poor Box, your heart will discover the true meaning of Christmas as you help those who are suffering and poor who long for the coming of the Lord.

PROPERTY TAX REBATE

To help with the rising cost of living, you are reminded that Pennsylvania Property Tax/Rent Rebate Program applications are now available. There are new guidelines which will permit individuals that qualify to receive rebate between \$250 and \$650 from property taxes or rent paid last year. Funding for this rebate program is made possible by the Pennsylvania State Lottery Fund and is a rebate that does not have to be repaid. This application must be filed by December 31, 2016.

To qualify, you must be 65 years of age or older, a widow or widower 50 years of age or older, or a disabled person 18 years or older. Homeowners that have annual incomes of \$35,000 or less and renters with annual incomes of \$15,000 or less could qualify. Only half of your annual Social Security or SSI income is counted toward the income guideline.
