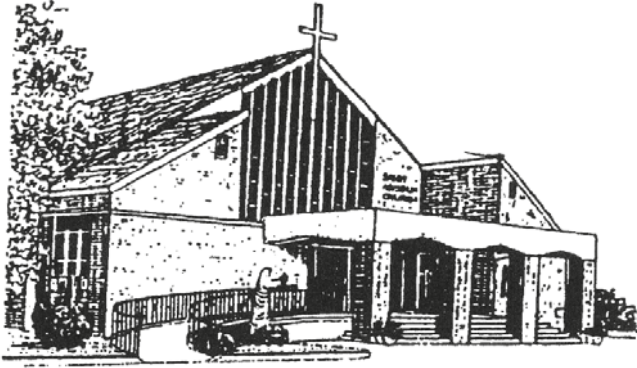

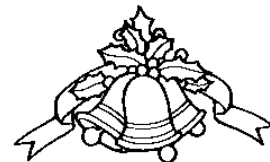
Advent CD's & Reading Material
