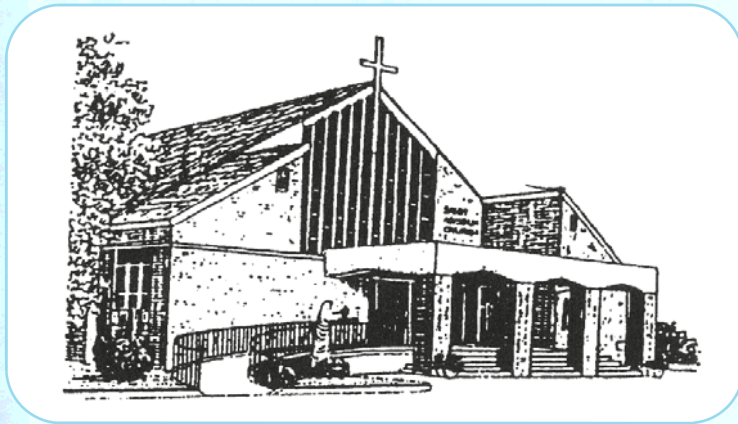

Some friendly Lenten reminders:

+ *FASTING* +

Fasting and external penitential practices are accompanied by an inner attitude of conversion. One goes without food and applies physical discipline to “chastise one’s own soul” (Lev. 16:31), to humble oneself before God (Dan. 9:3) and/or to prepare oneself for an encounter with God.

The Church urges all Catholics to voluntarily choose acts of penance on all days of Lent. The minimal obligations are:

Ash Wednesday & Good Friday: days of fast and abstinence

Fridays in Lent: days of abstinence

Fasting: all Catholics over 18 years and under 59 years

Abstinence: all over 14 years

Fuel Assistance Program

The cost of home heating continues to have a major impact on monthly budgets. To assist people with these rising costs, the Pennsylvania Home Heating Fuel Assistance Program (LIHEAP) is now in progress. The Fuel Assistance Program is available to people of all ages within the income guidelines. For example, individuals with a monthly income less than \$1,507 or a two-person household with a monthly income under \$2,030 qualify for the grant. Call United Social Services, 215-923-1900, Monday thru Friday between 10 AM and 4 PM. A staff worker will explain the eligibility requirements, answer your questions and assist you in completing an application. This grant is provided to all who qualify and does not have to be repaid. All inquiries are strictly confidential.
