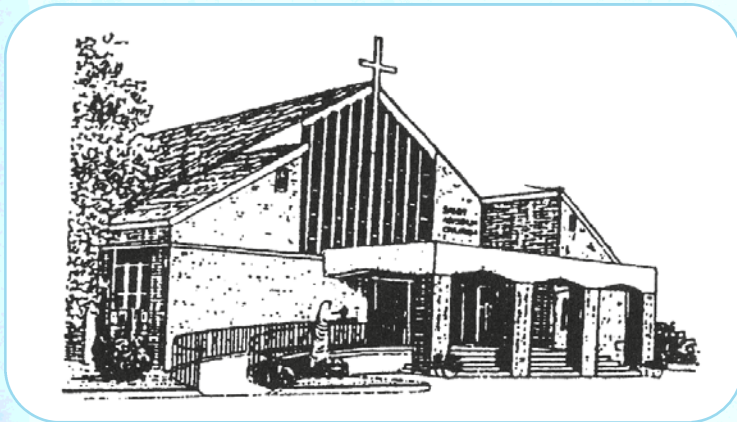

Greetings, my friends:
