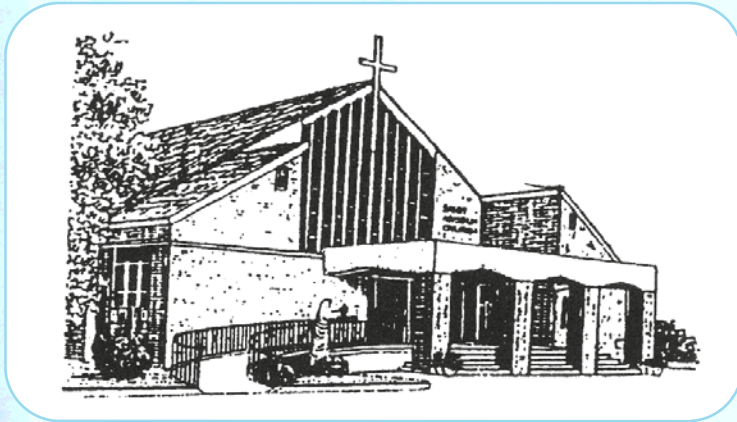

A Second Sunday of Lent greeting to you:

We are already into the second full week of the holy season of Lent. Once again, time moves along very quickly. It may be a good time to ask yourself "What am I doing for Lent, 2017?" Has anything been done? Did you begin and have a bit of a set-back? Is your Lent moving along just the way that you planned? In any of these cases, we still have a good four weeks remaining in this Lenten season. Please take advantage of the time. Please make sure that your soul is prepared to receive the Risen Christ on Easter morning.

A few things to catch-up on....On Wednesday evening, February 22, we celebrated the reception of the Sacrament of First Penance with our young parishioners. Both our Second Graders from school and our Prep Program participated in a wonderful evening, accompanied by their parents and teachers. The theme of the First Penance was: "Stay Awake; Be Ready." As each student returned from their first confession, they were greeted at the altar with an "owl" decoration, which they attached to the large antependium in the sanctuary. The owl was a reminder to them of the need to "stay awake" when it comes to temptation. It is a lesson that all of us should take into consideration during this time of Lent. A thank you to all who were responsible for a seamless night and service: Mrs. Murphy, Mr. Polselli, Mrs. Leonetti, Mrs. Granroth, Mrs. Dunn, Mrs. Clark, Mrs. Mucerino, our parents, and the children themselves. God bless you all.

On March 1, we obviously began our Lenten Season with Ash Wednesday. Our St. Anselm Church was very busy from the 6:30 AM Mass in the morning until our closing Mass at 7:00 PM. Many of our faithful passed through the doors of our church to receive the sacred sign of their Lenten duties and promises. Our school children received their ashes during a special service at 1:00 in the afternoon. Because of the homily that I was to give at the service, I let my hair grow a little longer than it normally is. I also did not shave for four days. The reason was that I wanted to focus on the words of the gospel on Ash Wednesday, "... when you are fasting, comb your hair and groom your face..." I processed into the service with my hair messed-up and with no shave. (Afterward, I found out that several parents and teachers were asking one another if I was OK☺). With the help of Mrs. Graham's first grade class, they questioned me about the words of the gospel, and my appearance. With that, I sat at a table in the center aisle, combed my hair and also shaved in front of our school community. It I talk the talk, I have to walk the walk...

Our annual "Night at the Races" was successfully renewed last Saturday night in the church hall. Always an exciting evening, this year the attendance surpassed the expectations of everyone. With a hall filled with supporters of our awesome school, the evening was packed with many different activities. The highlight of my night was to announce the horses before the race. I also enjoy going from table to table to chat with all those in attendance. Way too much information...I really love those pretzel rivets! Thank you to Jim Socha and his committee of faithful workers and volunteers who came together to make the night a memorable one. Like the 19154 5K, there is so much preparation that goes into the planning of such an evening. The preparation, like so many activities for the support of our school, is always done with love and care. Thank you to our sponsors, our contributors, and to all of our supporters.

As you saw and heard last week, the Lenten Crosses have returned. If you have not picked one up yet, please do so today. Also, we have some extra copies of our Lenten Black Book for meditations. Once again, if you haven't already done so, please take a copy. You may also take one or two if you know someone who is not a parishioner but may find our book useful. Once again, thank you to our Evangelization Committee for their work on the crosses.

Enough for now. Please remember that after the Sunday 8 & 10 AM Masses today, there is our Pancake Breakfast. Also, next Saturday evening, we have our annual "Broadway Concert," to be held in Our Lady of Victory Hall. Preceding the concert, our Ladies of St. Anselm will have a pasta dinner in the church hall. It is our way of providing a dinner theatre atmosphere to our concert event. As I experienced last year, it is truly a wonderful evening.

May God continue to bless you and your family. May our good Lord give you the courage, patience, and strength to make this Lenten Season an enriching and holy one for you. God bless you.

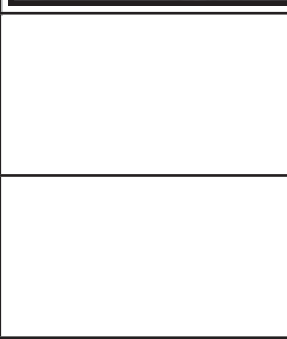
