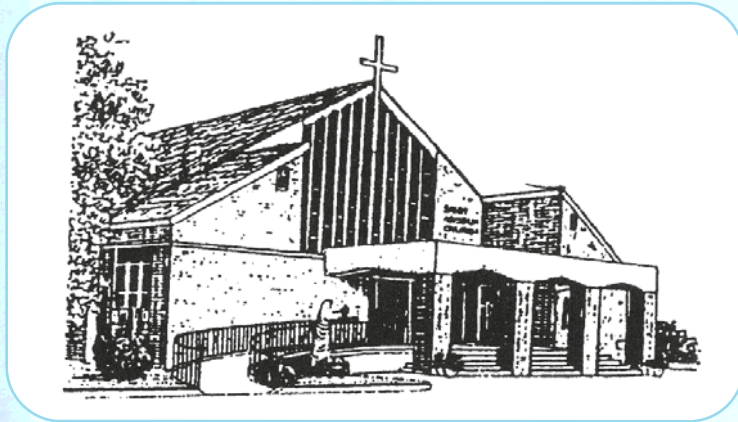

## **Greetings for this Fifth Sunday of Lent:**

**The Fifth Sunday of Lent always holds a bit of a promise for us. It is the in between Sunday from Laetare Sunday (which means, “Rejoicing”) to the celebration of Palm Sunday next week. The Fifth Sunday gives us a breath from the Lenten sacrifices we have begun (or begun again), and the supreme reflection and devotion to the Holy Week observances quickly approaching.**

**Today’s Gospel reading is that of a woman who was condemned by the religious authorities of the time. Jesus is questioned about her case. He proceeds to give an unforgettable lesson of mercy to all who were involved with the situation.**

**The preceding paragraph leads very nicely into a review of our recently conducted Forty Hours Devotions. If you were able to attend our nightly services, you heard the above mentioned Gospel on Monday evening. Our presenter, Fr. Jim Olson, gave us a wonderful explanation of how Jesus’ response to the woman’s situation was almost an actual definition of Our Holy Father’s call for this Extraordinary Jubilee Year of Mercy. We thank Fr. Olson for his presentations on all three evenings. His perspective of spending over 25 years of his priesthood in the high school ministry was reflected many times in the good natured and powerful stories that he has gleaned through experiences shared with high school students. Fr. Olson is always welcome here at St. Anselm Parish.**

**I had a first time experience last weekend to attend the Home and School Association’s “Night at the Races.” As all of my encounters with our parish functions have been during my first year, it was Awesome! What a night... First, there were the tables set up with all the goodies from the H&S—and the many goodies that folks brought with them to enhance their dining experience.
