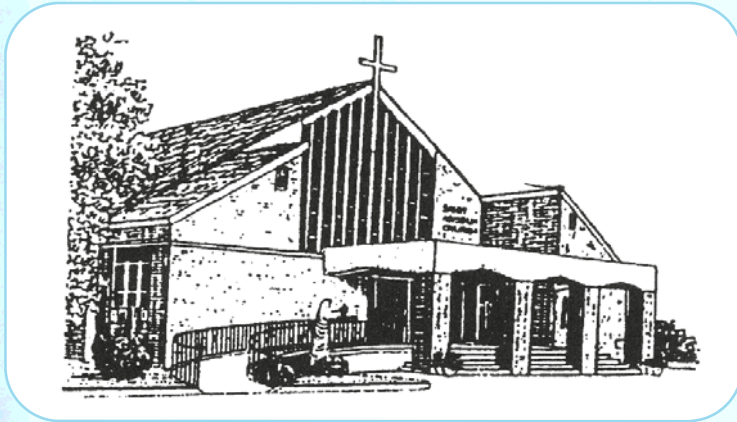

Therefore, the normal Tuesday/ Wednesday transmission of our bulletin to the printer may be affected...I hope that your Lenten Season is progressing in the manner that you envisioned three weeks ago. There are still many crosses and meditation books available at the entrances of our church. It’s hard to believe, however, we are nearing the mid-point of Lent. Please continue on the spiritual path that will lead you to Our Lord’s Resurrection.

Just a few things today, as I must be brief for early transmission...Thank you to Our Ladies of St. Anselm for their wonderful and delicious tradition of the “Pancake Breakfast”, especially on the cold Sunday morning that it was, the hot cakes, sausage, hot coffee, and warm friendship did the body and soul well. A little known fact about the pancake breakfast: as I was making my nightly rounds around our property, I noticed that the lights were on in the church hall at 8:00 PM. As I went downstairs to the hall, I was greeted by many of the ladies already preparing the hall and the goodies for Sunday morning. We are most grateful here at St. Anselm for “our ladies.” What wonderful work they do for all of our activities and fundraisers. Thank you once again.

If you are reading this in church on Saturday night, (of course, not during Mass), please don’t forget about our Pasta Dinner, right after Mass in the church hall followed by our Broadway Concert in Our Lady of Victory Hall at 7:30 PM. Once again, it is our St. Anselm version of a dinner theatre. Hope to see you there...

As long as we are talking about winter weather, I would like to mention the costs to our parish so far this winter. For both December and January, our PGW gas bills-for all of our buildings-were in excess of \$12,000 per month. The entire winter season could see the total PGW expense being in excess of \$50,000. So far this winter, not including what was going to happen this week, our snow removal expenses have been over \$5,000. We are certainly grateful to our faithful parishioners who help us out, both with the weekly collections and the “Building and Grounds” contributions. However, this winter, we may have to incorporate our “winter expense” envelope in an additional collection. I’ve never requested this before; however, this winter is proving to be “interesting.” Also, the roof in our chapel is leaking and we are awaiting the roofer as I type...

Anyway Mrs. Lincoln, how was the play? Once again, please be devoted to your Lenten plans and promises. It is never too late to start; it is never too late to start over. Happy (belated) St. Patrick and St. Joseph Feast Days to you. God bless you.

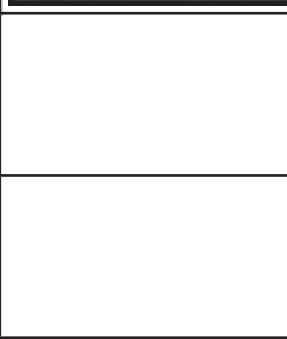
