A Blessed Palm Sunday Greeting to you:

Palm Sunday has, indeed, arrived. Where have the forty days of Lent gone? All of the preparations and intentions that we made on Ash Wednesday, where have they gone? Hopefully, we are prepared to celebrate the Triduum this week, ending with the glorious Resurrection of Our Lord on Easter Sunday.

The Triduum

Triduum is derived from a Latin word meaning three. *Triduum* is a Church word referring to the three days during which the Church gathers for prayer to commemorate the Passover of the Lord – the Paschal mystery. The Triduum begins with the Evening Mass of the Lord's Supper and continues through Easter. The Church sees these three days as one continuous time of prayer.

Holy Thursday – March 24th

Mass of the Lord's Supper – 7:00 PM

The holy oils blessed by Archbishop Chaput at the Mass of the Oils on Holy Thursday morning will be presented and placed in the ambry.

The Washing of Feet commemorates the ritual action of Jesus calling his disciples to imitate his loving service to God and people.

Adoration at the Repository will follow the Liturgy until 10:00 PM.

Good Friday – March 25th

Church will be opened for visit & prayer at 8:00 AM. The Church will remain open for prayer throughout the day.

Morning Prayer – 8:30 AM

On Good Friday, the morning prayer of the Church lifts the minds and hearts of those who pray to give praise and thanks to God for the grace God gave to Jesus during his agony, scourging, crowning, carrying of the cross and crucifixion which has made forgiveness of sin and new life possible for us.

Midday Prayer – Noon

Midday Prayer on Good Friday provides us with an opportunity to pray at the hour when Jesus was nailed to the cross. Jesus willingly adhered himself to the cross so that new life would be possible for all of us.

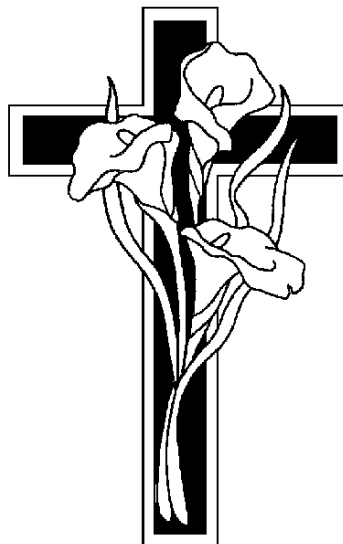
