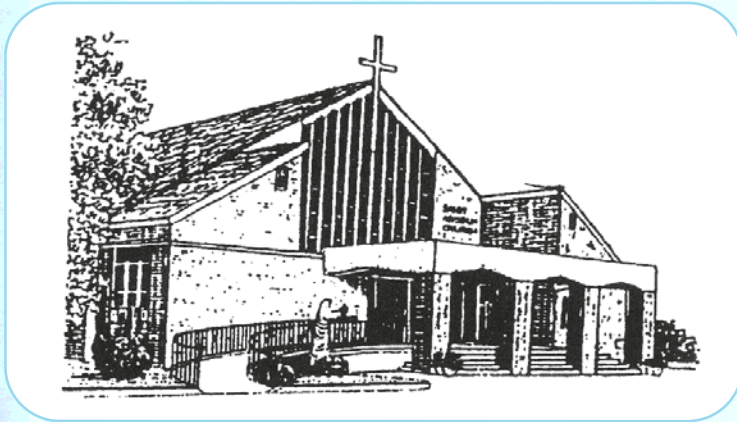

A “half-way point” of Lent greeting to all:

“The half way point.” Most times, this expression is used as a sports reference: half way of a horse race; half way of a marathon run; half way of a hurdles race. We can look at “half way” in two different ways. We can look at where we’ve been, or we can look where we are going. In the case of our spiritual time of grace afforded by this Lenten Season, we can actually accomplish both. Take a moment or two of spiritual reflection to see where the past 20 days or so have taken you, considering the goals that you may have placed on yourselves since Ash Wednesday. Are you holding on to your promises and sacrifices? Have your efforts been more sporadic than you would have liked? The half way point enables you to look back to where you have been (much like a hurdler who can look back and see which hurdles were completed and which ones were knocked over). But, the second way we can look at the half way point is to look forward to the time and opportunities in front of us. If this Lent has been successful, press on dear friends. If a miss-step or two, keep moving forward with the hurdles to come. Remember, Holy Week and Easter are now closer than they were before. If we look at these Paschal times and Resurrection as the finish line, then we are to continue to move ahead in preparing our hearts and souls for these special times. “Half way.” Keep Going!

For example, individuals with a monthly income less than \$1,485 or a two-person household with a monthly income under \$2,002 qualify for the grant. A staff worker will explain the eligibility requirements, answer your questions and assist you in completing an application. This grant is provided to all who qualify and does not have to be repaid. 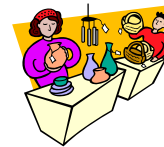
