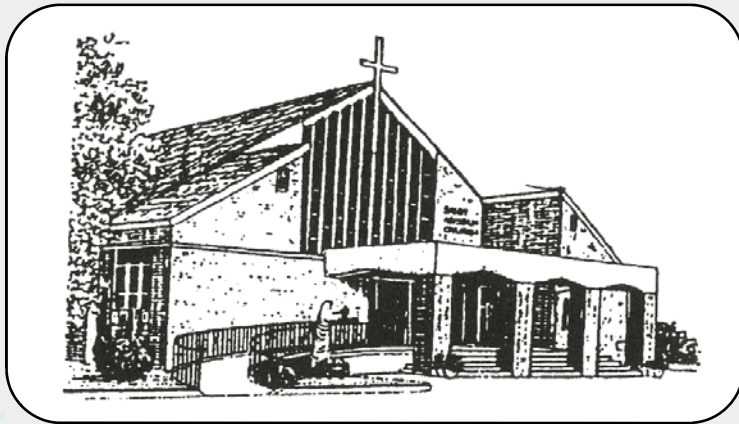

A Third Sunday of Lent Greeting to all:

Third Sunday of Lent. This week marks the middle point of our Lenten Season already. Time flies when you are giving up something; or maybe, it could be the other way around...As the days are getting a bit longer, and Spring should be right around the corner, we begin to see the proverbial “light at the end of the tunnel.” “Halftime” is always a good way to evaluate what has taken place so far. Once again, keep working towards the beautiful and fulfilling Feast of the Resurrection of Our Lord. All efforts and sacrifices should be with that final goal in mind. Please be ready, spiritually, for Easter this year.

SAINT ANSELM SCHOOL BUILDING SAFETY AND SECURITY

Unfortunately, in the day and age in which we live in, we have seen too many tragedies involving school students while they are going about their regular school days. To this issue, I am addressing some of the problems that we currently have concerning our St. Anselm School Building.

As many of you are familiar, our Church and School buildings were designed according to a theology and thought that existed many years ago. The idea was that the school and the church buildings were to be connected to show how the lessons taught in both venues would be transferred from one another and, eventually, into the world. Wonderful idea, back then. Add to this, the addition of our Parish Center building, and there are now TOO MANY ways to access our school. Today, again because of the many school tragedies with unauthorized people entering the school building, we need to do something to secure our school building.

To this end, the church doors leading to the school WILL BE LOCKED AT ALL TIMES WHEN SCHOOL IS IN SESSION! This will include during the weekday 8:30 Mass as well as all funeral Masses. The bathroom facilities that are located in the basement of the church hall will now be available. The school children do not access this part of the building until lunch time, around 12:00 Noon. If there is a later funeral, the restrooms in the Parish Center may be used. The Parish Center restroom may also be used by the handicapped.

Also, beginning this week, the “Aid For Friends” freezer has been moved to the History Room, adjacent to the Parish Center. We will require anyone who is dropping off meals to please enter and exit through the Parish Center. In the course of the next week or so, persons will not be able to enter the school through the History Room without a key.

The changes in the procedures above should be evident. I am not trying to place undue burdens on anyone. Those of you who attend our 8:30 Mass and who contribute so wonderfully to the Aid For Friends are obviously not the threat to our school or students. However, most times those who cause the tragedies in the schools are admitted, or get in, through an OPEN DOOR! Such was the case recently in Florida. Many leaders have been chastised for not being pro-active to the situation. I am attempting here to be pro-active and to ask for the cooperation of all of our good St. Anselm Parishioners. I know that you will stand with me. If however, you find that a door is open by mistake or error, please DO NOT take advantage of it. Don’t think that you got away with one. Rather, please inform our sacristan or the Parish Center or a Priest IMMEDIATELY!

Everyone has to be on-board with this for the safety and protection of our St. Anselm School students and community. Also, I will address the locations of new restrooms in the lobby of the church. This may include the eliminating or downsizing of the “cry room.” I will see what I can do. Actually, this should have been done years ago...

Enough for now...I am open to your comments and ideas on the above. I am certainly not an expert on these things; however, we all need to be PRO-ACTIVE NOW!! God bless you.
