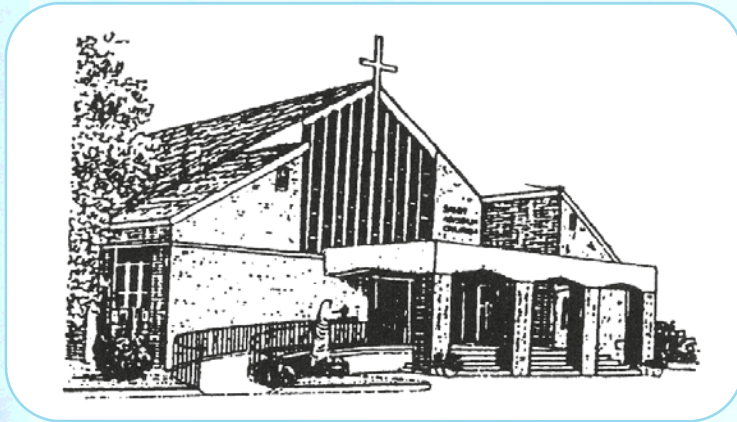

A very Happy and Blessed Easter Greeting to All:

Please let me extend a very Blessed and Happy Easter to all. As you know, this is my second Easter with you, as your Pastor. It is a humble reminder to me of my ministry with and for you. Our faith begins with our celebration of the Lord's Resurrection. All that the Lord endured during Holy Week comes to its fulfillment and completion with the joy and promise of Easter morning. He is Alive.....Indeed!!

The Resurrection of Jesus demonstrated the greatest power ever seen on earth – the power to raise the dead to life! Note the effects that the Resurrection also had on the disciples. The disciples went from experiencing fear to courage; despair to hope; anxiety to calm; turmoil to peace; sadness to joy.

As you look back on the season of Lent, I pray that your experience of the merciful love of Jesus has enriched your faith. I pray that your encounters with Jesus, during the season of Lent, were an opportunity for Jesus to grace you with healing, recovery, resurrection and new life. How blessed we are to be given a share in the greatest power which continues to raise us up. May our troubled and turbulent world, may sad and sorrowful hearts, may addicted and anxious spirits, may broken and battered lives become open to Jesus whose compassionate mercy will pick them up and carry them to the green pastures and refreshing waters of God's love where they will experience healing, recovery and new life.

One of the traditions of the Easter Vigil, and at the Masses on Easter Sunday, is the renewing of our Baptismal Vows. For most of us, these Promises were made, on our behalf, by our Godparents. Today, we have an opportunity to say "I do" for ourselves. Like last year, I conveyed an explanation of the purpose and power of the Baptismal Promises. I would like to share this, once again with you:

Renewal of Baptismal Promises

Catholics are called to implement the Resurrection into their lives by constant moral effort.

There is in our world a power at work that envies, that starves people, that exploits others, that kills. There is a force at work in our world that tires, isolates, and despairs. That force is evil. Evil is the culprit that robs and wounds the human soul.

In the face of evil, we remember that the Resurrection is not merely a past event confined to long ago.

The power of the resurrection is at work:

whenever justice is triumphing over the instincts of domination

whenever grace is winning out over the power of sin

whenever love is getting the better of selfish interests

whenever hope is resisting the lure of cynicism or despair

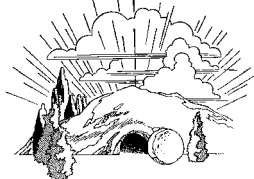
And so, on Easter, we renew our baptismal promises: we proclaim to do our best to rise with Christ and live more fully our Catholic life.

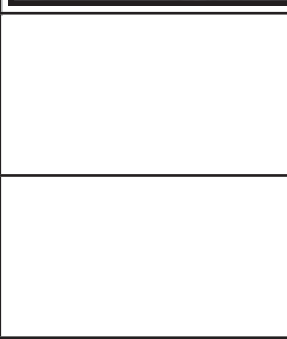
