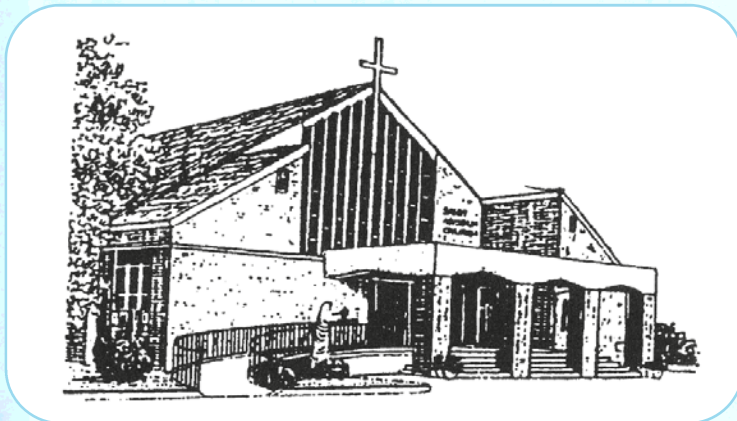

Finally, thanks to all who called and visited me. I may have been an ill man for a while, but I know that I am also a blessed man here at St. Anselm!**

I was able to attend, share some pizza, enjoy the D.J., and even acquired a tattoo (temporary!). Thanks to all who organized and chaperoned the affair. Thanks to all who were able to attend our “Broadway Concert.” Thanks to our Ladies of St. Anselm for their wonderful dinner beforehand. Thanks to all who performed. Thanks to Mrs. Leonetti for “knitting all of the threads together.”**

**Thanks to Mrs. Bowes and Miss Wolf and our Drama Club for their re-enactment of the Living Stations. The group demonstrated their talents in front of our school community, the Wednesday morning of Holy Week. The Drama Club also assisted in the solemnity of Good Friday by, once again, presenting the events of Jesus’ actions and words on His way to Calvary. Thank you, Drama Club.**
