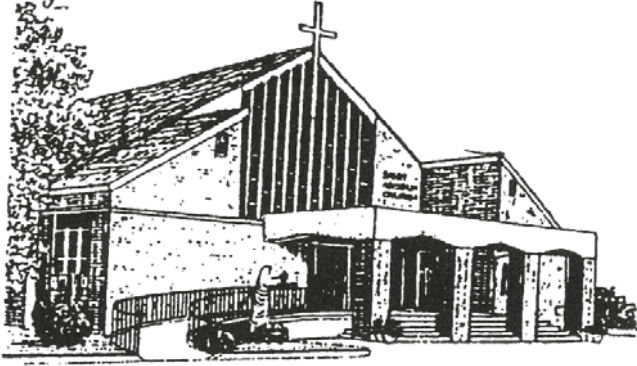

**From a fiscal and physical standpoint, the Summer months are always a good time to give a bit of a "State of the Parish" Report. As many of you have seen, we finally repaired the parking lot in the front of the church. Over the years, many cracks and holes developed. The cost of the paving, with a patch also near the Prayer Garden, cost about \$17,000. Next, we will have a new air conditioning unit installed in the next couple of weeks. One of the four units that we have is an original unit, almost twenty years old. Many of us are familiar with this one because of its start up noises that we hear during Mass. Many thought the noises were from my homilies...The cost of the new unit will be about \$16,000. Other physical improvements to be made this summer will include concrete work around the church building and the school. Most of the expenses are paid for through our "Building and Grounds" collection. You may think that, as a second collection, your dollars don't go too far. Let me assure you, we are making these dollars work. The collection has been down for the past couple of months. Don't be deterred. The results of that collection continue to fund the many projects that are needed to keep our building and grounds in "tip-top" shape.**

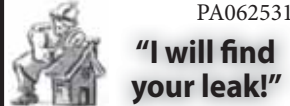
