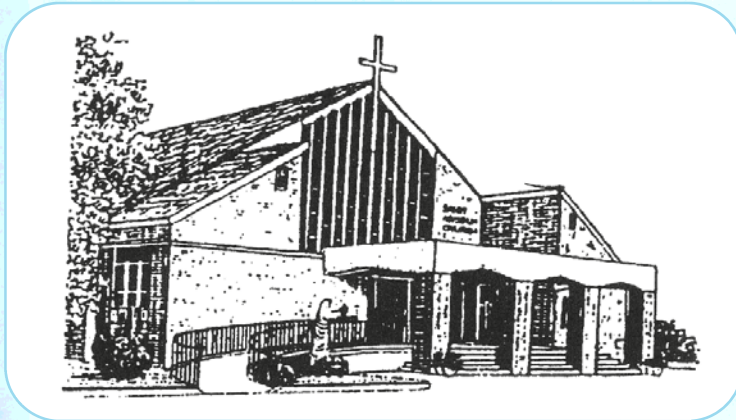

**Yet another warm July greeting to all:**

**Hopefully, this hot summer weather has not drained too much out of you. Certain situations or events in our lives can be like the hot summer sun, constantly beating down upon us. During these hot times, try and take some comfort in the Lord. It would not be correct to say that Our Lord is “shady”; however, He can provide the shade that we need when life becomes a little too intense.**

**Some saints for this week:**

**St. Camillus de Lillis, Tuesday, July 18. Born and died in Italy. At the age of nineteen he took service with his father, an Italian noble, against the Turks and, after four years hard campaigning, found himself, through his violent temper, reckless habits, and inveterate passion for gambling, a discharged soldier. He was obliged to work as a laborer on a Capuchin convent which they were then building. A few words from a Capuchin friar brought about his conversion, and he resolved to become a religious. Thrice he entered the Capuchin novitiate, but each time an obstinate wound in his leg forced him to leave. He entered the hospital of St. Giacomo, of which he became, in time, the superintendent. The carelessness of the paid chaplains and nurses toward the suffering patients now inspired him with the thought of founding a congregation to minister to their wants. With this end he was ordained a priest in 1586. Summoned at every hour of the day and night, the devotion of Camillus never grew cold. With a woman's tenderness, he attended to the needs of his patients. He wept with them, consoled them, and prayed with them. One day a sick man said to the Saint, "Father, may I beg you to make up my bed? It is very hard." Camillus replied, "God forgive you, brother! You beg me! Don't you know yet that you are to command me, for I am your servant and slave." "Would to God," he would cry, "that in the hour of my death one sigh or one blessing of these poor people might fall upon me!" His prayer was heard. Saint Camillus is the patron saint of nurses, the sick, and of hospitals.**

**St. Mary Magdalene, Saturday, July 22. She is one of the greatest saints of the Bible and a legendary example of God's mercy and grace. The precise dates of her birth and death are unknown, but we do know she was present with Christ during his public ministry, death and resurrection. She is mentioned at least a dozen times in the Gospels. Mary Magdalene has long been regarded as a prostitute or sexually immoral in western Christianity, but this is not supported in the scriptures. It is believed she was a Jewish woman who lived among Gentiles, living as they did. The Gospels agree that Mary was originally a great sinner. Jesus cast seven demons out of her when he met her. After this, she told several women she associated with and these women also became followers. Despite the scholarly dispute over her background, what she did in her subsequent life, after meeting Jesus, is much more significant. She was certainly a sinner whom Jesus saved, giving us an example of how no person is beyond the saving grace of God. During Jesus' ministry, it is believed that Mary Magdalene followed him, part of a semi-permanent entourage who served Jesus and his Disciples. Mary likely watched the crucifixion from a distance along with the other women who followed Christ during His ministry. Mary was present when Christ rose from the dead, visiting his tomb to anoint his body only to find the stone rolled away and Christ, very much alive, sitting at the place they laid Him. She was the first witness to His resurrection. She is the patroness of converts, repentant sinners, sexual temptation, pharmacists, and women.**
