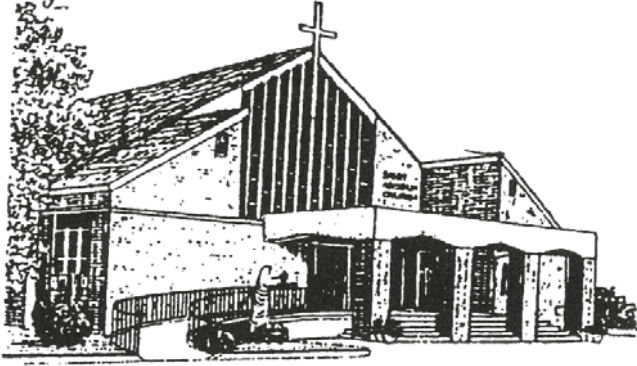

**A Mid-Summer greeting to all:**

**As the summer continues to move along at a gallop's pace, we are always reminded of the hot days that Jesus must have spent during his public ministry. Long hot days; long hot nights. Every once in a while, we may think that Our Lord really doesn't know exactly how we feel. Sometimes we may think that He is so distant from us. It is always good to remind ourselves that Jesus, too, lived on this earth. It is that wonderful connection that we have with the Son of our Creator that makes our faith so special. When we pray to our God, we are praying not only to the God who created us, but also to the God who knows exactly what it is like to live life on this earth, day by day—no matter how hot it gets.**

**I remember last summer, as I was getting used to preparing these articles for the bulletin, that I shared a few stories from my past life. Last summer, I wasn't exactly sure how I wanted to go about this procedure. I have gotten a bit "wordy" over the past year. Yes, I know that you noticed.☺**

**A story about not knowing where I was going...**

**When one of my nephews was young, I was designated to go with him to a weekend camping trip at Camp Hart for the Cub Scouts. Camping isn't really my thing. Give me a wrapped up bar of soap and a "sterilized cup for your protection" at a Holiday Inn and I'm dancin'. Anyway, away we went to the weekend camp. Many neat activities were accomplished during our three days together. Most were successful; one was Not! As Saturday afternoon was upon us, our activity was to row a small boat from the dock to a small "island that was at the other end of the lake". Sounds simple, doesn't it? Well...two people who grew up in Mayfair, one the cub scout, the other, the adult, had absolutely no clue how to row the boat forward!! We spent almost a half an hour literally "going in circles." At a certain point, my nephew says to me: "You don't have any idea what you're doing, do you, Uncle Bill?" No truer words were ever spoken. Hearing those words after 30 minutes of unfruitful rowing, we docked the boat only about ten yards from where we actually embarked, and waited for everyone to return.**

**Sometimes, we may feel that our lives are going in a series of circles. We spin our wheels in many facets of our life; sometimes, including our spiritual lives. The interesting thing about the shape of a circle is that it has no beginning and it has no end. The same applies to God, our Father. And what better person is there to understand us when our lives and brains and hearts and souls are spinning, sometimes we think, out of control.**

**Again, as I said in the beginning, the heat of our daily lives is understood, and lived out, by Jesus, our Lord. And when our world goes spiraling around and away from us, our God knows exactly what we are going through. A prayer always to God, in the summer, and always for his help and guidance. With this assistance in our lives, maybe we can get that boat of ours out of the dock area, and row the boat where it needs to go.**
