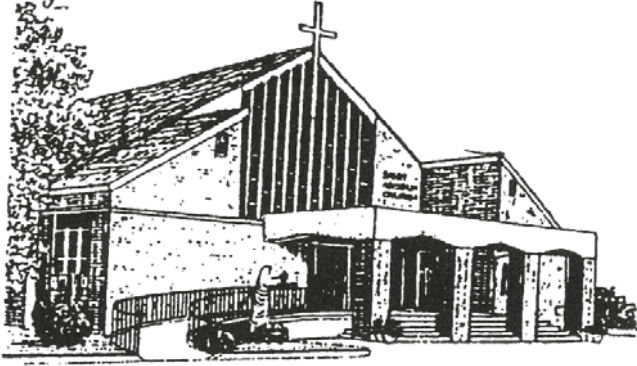

Many things have to go right for these kinds of figures to be achieved. Once again, a tremendous thank you to all who planned, prepared, volunteered, worked, and participated in our carnival. As you can see, there are tremendous Parish rewards for your efforts.**

**Thank you, also, to our Ladies of St. Anselm. Their hard work, dedication, and commitment to our parish for many years have been a blessing to all of us. Their allegiance and loyalty to both our parish and school has manifested itself time and time again over the years. This year, the Ladies of St. Anselm contributed \$14,200 to our parish. This amount is broken down to reflect \$10,200 earned by virtue of the Christmas Bazaar, Candy Sales, Pancake Breakfasts, and Spaghetti Dinners. The additional \$4,000 indicates the results of the Ladies Travel Club that also enhances our parish in wonderful ways. Again, a big THANK YOU to our Ladies of St. Anselm. Thanks, too, to their out-going President, Kathy Simmons. Outgoing in both the sense of her awesome personality and work-driven efforts, and out-going in the passing of her leadership onto a well-trained committee that will follow her. As the end of the prayer states: “...As it was in the beginning, is now, and ever shall be...” Well Done!**

**Last weekend, I had an opportunity to go to North Wildwood, for a St. Bernard Grade School Reunion. I had a really great time there. One of the members of our class was known here in our St. Anselm school community last year. Our school nurse, Mrs. McDonald, attended St. Bernard school with me. # *Saint Anselm SCRIP Program*

## *What is SCRIP?*

Participation in the SCRIP Program helps families pay tuition for Catholic education. This includes Grade Schools, High Schools and Colleges.

Gift cards are purchased in the SCRIP Office. A percentage of the purchase is credited toward the school of your choice. For those who do not have a child in Catholic School, the credit would then go to St. Anselm Parish or you may direct it to another family.

**Example:** Purchase food certificates  
 $\$100.00 \times 52 \text{ weeks} = \$5,200.00 \times 4\% \text{ tuition reimbursement} = \$208.00 \text{ per year.}$

## *Registration:*

All SCRIP buyers must provide registration information. Forms are available in the SCRIP office.

We are located in Room “B” – enter via the school parking lot.

## *SCRIP Policy:*

- All checks must have a telephone number and may require proof of identification  
Maximum check value \$300.00
- If a check is returned for insufficient funds the purchaser is responsible for the check's value and any additional charges incurred
- Purchasers are asked to review your receipts and count your certificates before leaving
- Cash purchases require exact change
- No refunds or exchanges

## *Credit Distribution:*

Credits of \$25.00 or more are disbursed twice a year (January and August). Credit slips must be presented when applying your credit toward a tuition payment.
