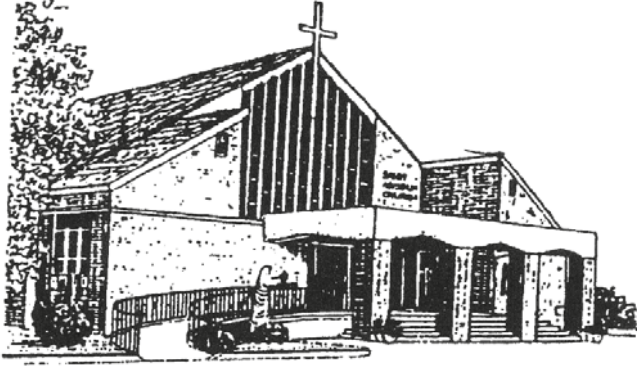

**An end of July greeting to everyone:**

We were born 10 days apart and the back of our houses faced each other across the alley. Mr. Inside and Mr. Outside we always were. Just before we graduated, John and I worked for Gino’s fast food, located at Cottman & Torresdale Aves. Upon graduating, we both figured that we would always be close by to one another; each of us, as they say today, “would have each other’s back.” However, around this time, at the end of July, John told me that he had enlisted in the United States Navy. As proud as I was of and for my friend, it still hit me like a ton of bricks. We had always done things together. Even though we always went to different schools, (except for kindergarten), we would somehow find each other after school, and proceed with our lives. A lesson learned, early in my life.**

**Sometimes, our relationships with others and with God can be the same. We get so accustomed and familiar with situations and circumstances that life does not allow us to reflect on all the benefits and blessings that we have at any one time. However, should something happen to that relationship or, should one of the parties no longer be a part of that relationship, suddenly things change drastically. As we all have learned, these types of things happen. Although it is not quite time for Thanksgiving, perhaps an acknowledgment of current blessings should take place periodically in our lives. Be thankful for the family and friends around you. In your thankfulness, perhaps a word or two of how you appreciate those persons in your life could be communicated to them. And certainly our relationship with the Lord should be looked at as often as we can. Perhaps God is taken for granted so many times in our life. We all have many blessings and gifts in our lives. A simple “thank you” everyday in prayer to our most gracious God should not be too much to expect of ourselves. Take time to enjoy and appreciate those around you. Sometimes, we wait until...**

## *Information on Clearances required by School & Parish Volunteers*

As part of our Catholic commitment to safe environments, the Archdiocese recently updated its policies and training curriculum for mandated reporters of child abuse and neglect. If you have minimal contact with children, such as trip chaperones and event volunteers such as the Oktoberfest, Christmas Bazaar, Race for Education, Carnival, etc., you are required to provide the following clearances:

- Criminal Record Check
- Child Abuse Clearance
- Signed Mandated Reporter Acknowledgement Form (available at the Parish Center)
- Signed FBI Disclosure Statement if you have continuously lived in the State of Pennsylvania for ten years (available at the Parish Center); otherwise, an FBI Fingerprint Clearance is required (contact the Parish Center for additional information).

Persons with regular contact with children, including classroom volunteers, CYO coaches, most parish/school organization board members and committee chairpersons are required to provide the following:

- Criminal Record Check
- Child Abuse Clearance
- Signed Mandated Reporter Acknowledgement Form (available at the Parish Center)
- Signed FBI Disclosure Statement if you have continuously lived in the State of Pennsylvania for ten years (available at the Parish Center); otherwise, an FBI Fingerprint Clearance is required (contact the Parish Center for additional information).
- Safe Environment Program (class attendance necessary)
- Mandated Reporter Training (on-line program)

The FBI Disclosure Statement & Mandated Reporter Acknowledgement Form are available at the Parish Center for volunteers who have completed all other requirements. Please stop at your convenience to complete the form.

Clearances are now valid for five years. Individuals whose clearances are older than five years, were not previously required, or will expire, must be in full compliance with diocesan guidelines.

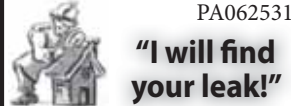
