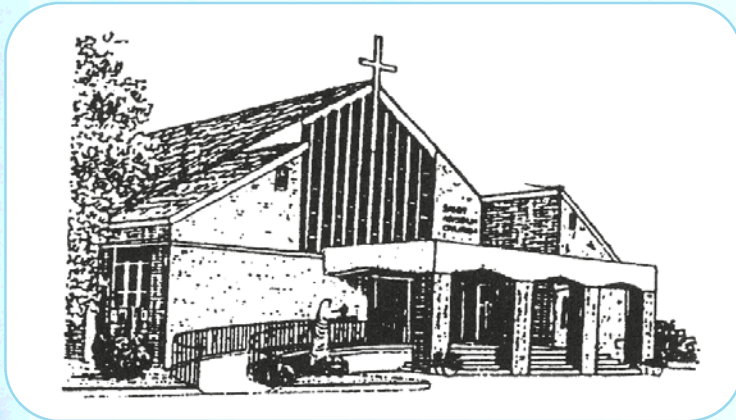

A “warm” July greeting to all:

With our Fourth of July celebrations now behind us, we move directly into our summer months. As in years past, the weather and the temperatures in summer often exceed our comfort levels. There is only so much air conditioning, water, pools, and fans that we can stand. Sometimes, our spiritual lives can experience the same kind of heat and intensity. As with an air conditioner, or fan, we should always be able to find the Lord in prayer, for Him to refresh and energize us through our difficult times. Sometimes the heat of life can be oppressive. At those times, always know where the Lord is in your life, and be able to “switch on” his cooling love and graces into your life.

Some feast days this week...

St. Benedict, Tuesday, July 11: Born in Nursia, Italy, died at the monastery that he founded in Monte Cassino. I always enjoyed that fact because, to me, Monte Cassino reminds me of a James Bond movie. St. Benedict was the son of a noble Roman family. He had a twin sister who later became St. Scholastica. St. Benedict gave away all of his worldly possessions and ambitions. His vocation as a monk actually began with him just taking a little vacation from his daily life. In other words, his vacation led to his vocation! Among other things, St. Benedict is the patron saint of gall stones and kidney disease.

St. Henry, Thursday, July 13: Born and died in Germany. St. Henry was the son of King Henry II, also known as Henry the Quarrelsome. (How’s your self esteem?) He was destined to become a priest; however, destiny intervened. He married a woman who later became St. Cunegunda, a feast we celebrate on March 3. St. Henry is the patron saint of: childless people, disabled persons, dukes, kings, and those rejected by religious orders.

St. Kateri Tekakwitha, Friday, July 14: Born in the Iroquois territory of New York state, she died in Caughnawaga, Canada. Kateri is known as the “Lily of the Mohawks.” Kateri’s mother and father met when her mother was taken captive by the Iroquois tribe and it was her future husband who rescued her. Talk about fate...However, both her mother and father died, along with a baby brother, from small-pox before Kateri was 4 years old. She was then sent to live with her aunt and uncle. Her uncle was the chief of the “Turtle Clan.” Kateri met a French missionary priest when she was 18 years old. Always a kind-hearted person, Kateri asked to be baptized in the Catholic faith. Her example of Christian living was an example to her own people, even to the French missionaries who encountered her. St. Kateri was canonized by Pope Benedict XVI on October 21, 2012. St. Kateri Tekakwitha is the patron saint of ecology.

May the cooling rays of Our Lord’s love and understanding be upon you.
