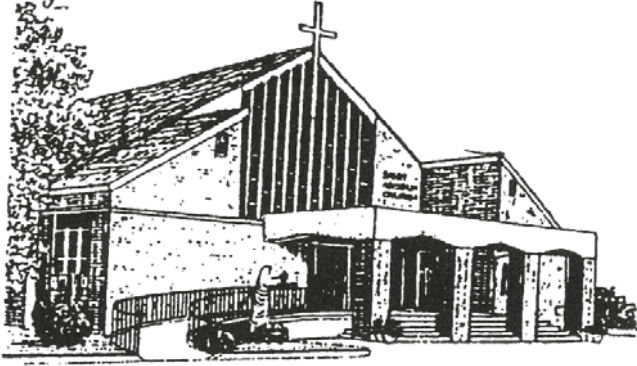

May the peace of Our Lord be with you:

Is it ever going to be cool again? These past couple of weeks have been unbearable, as far as the weather is concerned. One day seems to melt into another. Flowers wilt, lawns and grass turn brown, and air conditioning is pushed to their limits. If we think about it, we too, go through the same type of routine in the hot weather. We wilt. If we spend too much time in the summer sun, we also turn brown. And, our limits are stretched, too, seeking shelter and relief from the oppressive heat and sun.

It reminds me of something that happened to me years ago at a gas station. The gas station that I used at the time would always have people around the pumps who would offer to pump your gas for you. The station was not located in New Jersey and the people who offered their help were not employees of the gas station. I would always, politely, tell them that I could pump my own gas. But, you had to be aware of your surroundings. One day, as I was getting ready to pump gas into my car, a young woman was doing the same at the pump ahead of me. She seemed to be having a problem. She hollered over to me: “Sir, could you help me with my gas cap? I just bought this car, and it is the first time I’m filling the car with gas?” I instinctively and sarcastically thought to myself, “Ahh, the old ‘just got a new car story’...” I was very skeptical as to the truth of the request. I wondered whether the young woman was “in cahoots” with someone lurking around the pumps. I told her to wait until I finished with my car before I would tend to her needs. So, after I finished filling my gas tank, I locked my car, looked around, and proceeded to check out the request. Sure enough, her car was brand new. Sure enough, it was the first time that she tried to loosen the cap that had been put on in the factory. The gas cap was tight, indeed. Sure enough, she was a human being who needed help from a fellow human being. The night, as I reflected on my day, I realized that I had just taken part in a modern day version of “The Good Samaritan.” However, I was not the lead character or hero of the story. I was the Levite and the Priest in the story, who thought of six thousand different reasons why they could not help the person in need. I’ll never forget that day or the lesson that I learned from it. I have not yet used this story in my homily for The Good Samaritan but, you will hear it at some time...

In this hot, oppressive weather, let us look toward Our Lord, as our Good Samaritan. When life gets hot and oppressive and difficult, and things like our recent weather never seem to end, let us turn to the Lord for help. Jesus does not think of reasons not to help us. Rather, when we “cannot loosen our gas cap,” He is more than willing to come right over and help us. With all the “caps that we cannot loosen in our lives,” it is reassuring that the Lord is “at the pump next to us.”

Our Saint Anselm School community is getting ready to return for another school year. Our many parish groups and activities are poised to get moving soon. Please keep in mind our upcoming “Oktoberfest” and Car Show. “Vegas Chances,” are available at the Parish Center. Coming this Fall 2016, the Infant/Toddler Play Date Group. Back to School News

The school office is open daily from 9 AM to 2 PM.

Parents wishing to register or transfer students may come to the school office to do so. For more information regarding registration, please call the school office at 215-632-1133. Some grades do have a waiting list.

School reopens for students in Grades 1 to 8 on Wednesday, September 7.

Students in Grades 1 to 8 should report to school at 7:45 AM. Students only are to enter the school doors on Dunks Ferry Road and report to their new grades. Teachers will meet the students and escort them into their new classrooms. Dismissal for students in Grades 1 to 8 is 12 Noon.

Students in Kindergarten are to report to school on Thursday, September 8, at 9:30 AM.

Kindergarten students should enter the school through Door A in the back of the building. The Kindergarten teacher will meet the students in the schoolyard at Door A. Dismissal for Kindergarten students only will be at 11 AM on Thursday. School hours for Grades 1 to 8 on Thursday are 7:55 AM to 12 Noon.

Students in Prekindergarten are to report to school on Friday, September 9, at 9:30 AM.

Prekindergarten students should enter the school through Door A in the back of the building. The Prekindergarten teacher will meet the students in the PK classroom. Dismissal for Prekindergarten students only will be 11 AM on Friday. PK students will be dismissed from Door A in the schoolyard. School hours for Grades Kindergarten to 8 on Friday are 7:55 AM to 12 Noon.

Beginning Monday, September 12, school hours for all students (PK-8) are 7:55 AM to 2:50 PM.

Students in Grades PK to 8 are to be in full uniform beginning on the first day of school. Kindergarten and Prekindergarten students wear their Physical Education uniforms everyday. Students should bring a healthy snack to school each day. Pretzels will be sold beginning Monday, September 12.

School uniforms and physical education uniforms (PK-8) are to be purchased from Flynn & O'Hara Uniforms on Dutton Road (215-637-4600). If you plan to have your male child wear the white golf shirt, only white golf shirts with the Saint Anselm School logo are acceptable. No substitutions are permitted.

Parents of students in PK, K, and Grade 1 will receive letters with more information about the opening of school in the mail. Please watch for this mailing around the third week of August. If you do not receive your letter, please call school immediately so we may help you.

We look forward to a new academic year that will be both spiritually and academically enriching for your child. We know we can count on the support and cooperation of our parents as we minister together to help parents in their awesome responsibility of educating their children. Enjoy the remaining days of summer.
