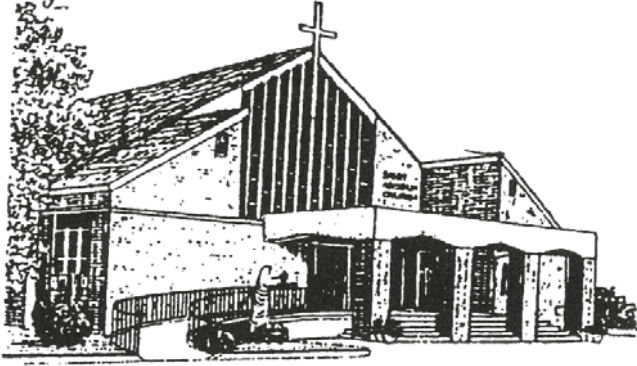

**Greetings, my Friends!**

**Once again, it is difficult to believe that another Summer is almost at an end. Where does the time go? First, we were celebrating Memorial Day and Ascension Thursday; next thing you know, it is the Feast of the Assumption (not a holy day of obligation this year), and now Labor Day is quickly approaching. Thank the Lord that the most recent of heat waves has ended. We have endured much this summer. Endured, with Our Lord's gentle and breezy comfort.**

**As September approaches, I am already retreating back to my "teacher mode." Many memories and stories return to me at this time of the year. I'd like to share this story with you. When I was teaching at Bishop McDevitt High School, every year we would take our Senior Class, for their retreat, to the Dominican Retreat House at Elkins Park. A beautiful setting for young folks to enjoy a retreat day. Both inside and outside of the complex was conducive to prayer and meditation. Also, there were out of the way places for the students to talk during the "silence" of the retreat.☺ After their lunch time, the students were permitted to walk the grounds, and then, return to the Chapel for the continuation of the retreat.**

**The first activity after lunch was a Prayer Service. The students were permitted to sit anywhere in the Chapel; although, they usually sat with their friends. However, one of the students asked me to sit next to her for the Prayer Service. Naturally, I was more than a little skeptical about the request. Was there a "whoopie-cushion" there; was it the "creaky" part of the pew; had someone left something on the pew that would cause laughter if I sat there? All these teacher things went through my mind in about two seconds after the student asked me to sit next to her. So, instinctively, I said "No." Seriously, a look of disappointment was clearly reflected on her face. I had just missed a golden opportunity to accept a gracious request by one of my students, who wanted nothing else than for me to sit next to her during the Prayer Service. Seeing her reaction, I quickly said that I thought I was going to be on the altar for the service, but I remembered that I wasn't needed. I, then, sat next to her for the Prayer Service and all turned out well.**

**In our everyday lives, how often do we miss those golden opportunities to share a quiet time or two with those around us? How many times do we think of so many excuses not to get together with those that we love and care for? How many times do we not talk to these same people-either accidentally or on purpose? How many times do these same impulses to not speak or deal with someone effect our relationship with God? The Lord is always calling us to "sit next to Him; always calling us to be in a dialogue with Him. How many times do we think of all kinds of excuses not to "sit with Him?" How many times do we put off praying to Him, for one reason or another, figuring that we will always have time to catch up? Now is the time to be in contact with those that we know and love. Now is the time to talk to someone, especially if that time may have come and gone. Now is the time to "sit next to the Lord." Just as the student made a simple request to me - and I turned it into something huge - don't miss the opportunities that you have in life to be with those who need you. Don't think of excuses not to be with those you love, especially when it comes to God.**

Saint Anselm school office is open daily from 9 AM to 2 PM.



Parents wishing to register or transfer students may come to the school do so. For more information regarding registration, please call the school office at 215-632-1133. Some grades do have a waiting list.

School reopens for students in Grades 1 to 8 on Wednesday, September 7.

Students in Grades 1 to 8 should report to school at 7:45 AM. Students only are to enter the school doors on Dunks Ferry Road and report to their new grades. Teachers will meet the students and escort them into their new classrooms. Dismissal for students in Grades 1 to 8 is 12 Noon.

Students in Kindergarten are to report to school on Thursday, September 8, at 9:30 AM.

Kindergarten students should enter the school through Door A in the back of the building. The Kindergarten teacher will meet the students in the schoolyard at Door A. Dismissal for Kindergarten students only will be at 11 AM on Thursday. School hours for Grades 1 to 8 on Thursday are 7:55 AM to 12 Noon.

Students in Prekindergarten are to report to school on Friday, September 9, at 9:30 AM.

Prekindergarten students should enter the school through Door A in the back of the building. The Prekindergarten teacher will meet the students in the PK classroom. Dismissal for Prekindergarten students only will be 11 AM on Friday. PK students will be dismissed from Door A in the schoolyard. School hours for Grades Kindergarten to 8 on Friday are 7:55 AM to 12 Noon.

Beginning Monday, September 12, school hours for all students (PK-8) are 7:55 AM to 2:50 PM.

Students in Grades PK to 8 are to be in full uniform beginning on the first day of school. Kindergarten and Prekindergarten students wear their Physical Education uniforms everyday. Students should bring a healthy snack to school each day. Pretzels will be sold beginning Monday, September 12.

School uniforms and physical education uniforms (PK-8) are to be purchased from Flynn & O'Hara Uniforms on Dutton Road (215-637-4600). If you plan to have your male child wear the white golf shirt, only white golf shirts with the Saint Anselm School logo are acceptable. No substitutions are permitted.

Parents of students in PK, K, and Grade 1 will receive letters with more information about the opening of school in the mail. Please watch for this mailing around the third week of August. If you do not receive your letter, please call school immediately so we may help you.

We look forward to a new academic year that will be both spiritually and academically enriching for your child. We know we can count on the support and cooperation of our parents as we minister together to help parents in their awesome responsibility of educating their children. Enjoy the remaining days of summer.
