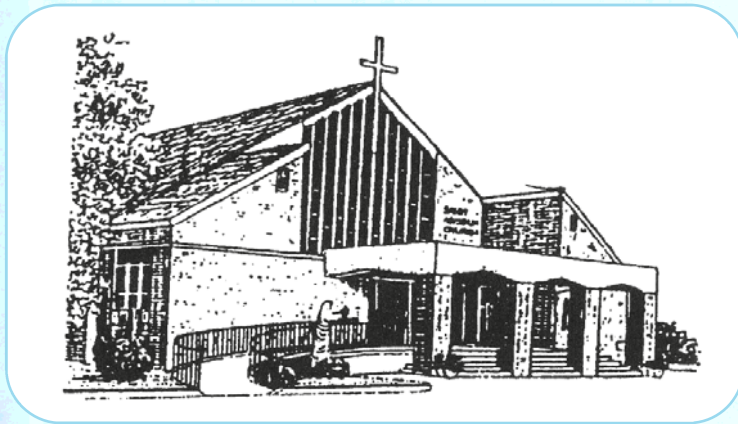

## **An Autumnal Greeting to All:**

This is now the third year that I am writing this in the bulletin. Each year I tell you that my favorite word is “autumnal.” And, of course, this is the only time of the year that I can use this word. When the official day of Fall would come about during the school year, I would have my students write the word “autumnal” in their notebooks. There is a generation of my students who are still trying to figure me out... Anyway, The Autumn season is always a good time to look at nature and see how we can apply the natural things of this world and adapt them to our spiritual life. Fall is the season when nature changes herself. The green leaves of summer begin to take on other colors. It’s not that the leaves are any less valuable; rather, they are entering into another phase of their existence. Sometimes there are things in our spiritual and prayer lives that are “green” and always seem to be moving along fine. But, when our prayer and spiritual lives start to change colors, it is OK to ask the Lord for His guidance in maybe making changes for the good of our relationship with Him. Most times, it is difficult to acknowledge that maybe our spiritual “greens” are not what they used to be. We always think that there is something wrong. Maybe, if we feel this way, it’s just time to try another approach. Every tree goes through different colors throughout the year and throughout its life time. The tree looks magnificent in any color. So do we in the eyes of God.

A few things to catch-up on...Last week, our St. Anselm Grade School opened for its 55<sup>th</sup> School Year. It was interesting on the first day. Early in the morning of Wednesday, September 6, it was raining very hard, especially around 7:00 AM. We all wondered whether our teachers, students and their families would have to deal with this inclement weather as they entered school that first morning. Around 7:20, the rained stopped and a few minutes later the sun came out. Weather conditions were all clear as our First through Eighth Grades entered our school building. I would later tell our 8<sup>th</sup> Graders that they were responsible for the sunshine. I told them that their leadership was already visible to the other students as they “allowed” the clear weather to occur so that the school day and year would begin perfectly. Another observation from the first day is that most of our First Grade students attended our school last year as Kindergarteners. Out of routine, most of them entered the front doors of the school and began to walk down the “other hallway” towards their old Kindergarten room. A funny but refreshing side of our young students.

The next day, Thursday, September 7, our Kindergarten students arrived. And in our 55<sup>th</sup> year, may I say that TWO classrooms of Kindergarten students entered our St. Anselm School. Many of the students were part of our PreK-4 Program last year. Some moved to another room in the hallway. Some students were new. We are truly grateful that word of our awesome school is getting out there. It is always our goal that the students who begin at St. Anselm, graduate from St. Anselm. Having two Kindergarten classes is a firm foundation of our school goals. Also, if I may, one of our Kindergarten students is my great-niece, whom I baptized here at St. Anselm five years ago.

The next, next day☺, Friday, September 8, we welcomed our PreK-4 class to school. Obviously, all new to our St. Anselm School, the students and their parents gathered outside of “A” door to come into our school for the first time. Smiles and tears were present on the part of both parents and students. Photographs for memories and gentle waves and hugs were all part of the morning. And then, a half hour later, we experienced-for the first time in 55 years- the beginning of our PreK-3 Program. Without waiting in line outside of the door, the new students and their parents came directly into our newly constructed and fabricated PreK-3 room. As I walked in, some of the students were already coloring at their little tables; one was playing with the large plastic trailer truck; one student was marveling at the white board screen. Truly, the students add to the beauty of our wonderful St. Anselm School Community.

Please note that most of this bulletin article has been devoted to St. Anselm Parish School. We are ALIVE AND WELL!
