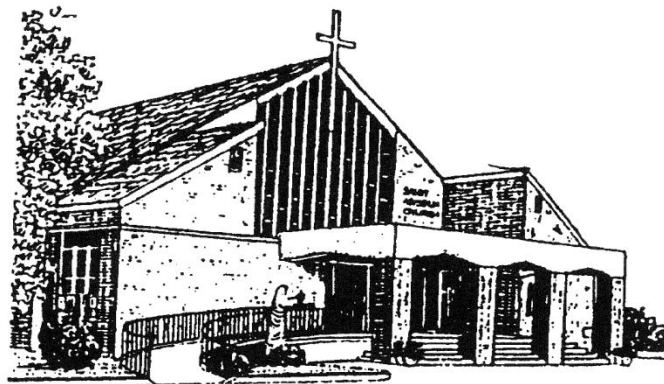

Responsibilities: This position requires an adult to prepare & teach weekly lessons to a class of approximately 15 participants assisting them in cultivating their Catholic Faith & deepening their relationship with God. Full materials & training are provided.

Qualifications: He or she should have an ability to communicate with & manage a group of children. Teaching experience is preferred, but not required, as classroom management & other teaching skills can be acquired through training & consultation sessions.

Commitment: Tuesday evenings from 6:30 to 8 PM, with an additional hour or two of lesson preparation at home each week
