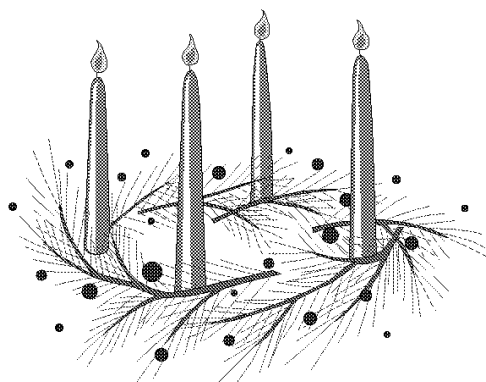

## **A Holy Advent Greeting to all our St. Anselm Parishioners:**

**This current Advent Season marks one of the few times that we will celebrate almost four weeks of Advent preparation. Just two days short of four full weeks have enabled us to make ready our hearts and souls to receive the Christ Child on Christmas morning.**

**As a follow-up on our Jubilee Year of Mercy, Pope Francis encourages three steps for our journey of Mercy:**

- 1. ENTER into Mercy's Holy Doors by practicing the Corporal and Spiritual Works of Mercy.**
- 2. ENCOUNTER Mercy by receiving the graces through the Sacrament of Reconciliation/ Penance.**
- 3. CONTEMPLATE Mercy through private reflection and, maybe, a Holy Hour.**

**Our awesome Parish has been quite busy as usual the past week or so. Our school students, especially Kindergarten through 5<sup>th</sup> Grade, put on a spectacular Christmas show, entitled: "Christmas in the Country." We thank (and welcomed back) Mrs. Regina Dunn, who directed the extravaganza. Even though we were still a few weeks away from Christmas, the songs and portrayals by the students put everyone into the spirit of the Season. (I even got an idea for my Christmas homily☺). Fr. Dunleavy was able to return for the afternoon production. A welcome back, also, to him.**

**A couple of days later, the confessions of Grades 3 through 8 were heard in church. Just before coming over to church, the students had been at Archbishop Ryan High School to see the play "Cinderella." Fr. Friel incorporated the theme of the play in his preparation of the students for them to receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation.**

**The New Evangelization Committee met officially for the first time last week. Many, Many good ideas surfaced and will be incorporated in the weeks and months to come. Remember, this committee is a direct result of the Parish Assemblies completed last year.**

**"Let there be Light!" Not only is this a verse from the Creation Account in the Book of Genesis but also it reflects the brightness of our church. All the bulbs in our chandeliers were replaced last week. As you may have noticed, we did not continue the tradition of having a "darkened church" for the beginning of Sunday Masses during Advent. I figured, with all of the light bulbs out, we didn't need to☺.) All should be light and bright for a while—I hope!!!**

**This past Sunday marked the distribution of the gifts that were on display in front of the Blessed Mother Altar. As you know, all of the gifts were there because of the generosity of our awesome St. Anselm parishioners. Ultimately, the tags for gifts come from the "Giving Tree" that is placed in church around Thanksgiving time.**

**We say thank you to Frank and Adele Nessel for once again coordinating and organizing the wonderful tradition that is so reflective of our caring Parish community here at St. Anselm. From the placing of the tags on the tree; to the packing of the gifts to be sent to those who need them, we are indebted to Frank and Adele, and to all those who work with them. Thank you!!**

**At my request, Fr. Friel took a photo of the Blessed Mother Altar just before we took the gifts down. I wanted a reminder for myself as to what would be needed next year. Fr. Friel went a step further, and put the photo of the altar on our Facebook page. Over twelve thousand people looked at our altar within a few hours of his posting the photo. Word is out there as to what a magnificent Parish we have here.**

**And, more is to come in this area of “social media.” Fr. Friel and others are composing what is to be called: “12 Days of Awesome!” The photos and stories will reflect what we are doing here at the Parish and with our wonderful school community. We need to get the word out as to how vibrant and alive our Parish and School is for Parkwood. More details on this endeavor will follow.**

**And so, off we journey into this last week of Advent. So much has been done; so much to be done. In all that you are doing to prepare for Christmas, don’t forget to take care of your soul. A reminder, our Parish Penance Service will be this Monday night, December 21, at 7:00 PM. Bring a relative; bring a friend. Incorporate the 2<sup>nd</sup> Step of Mercy, previously mentioned.**

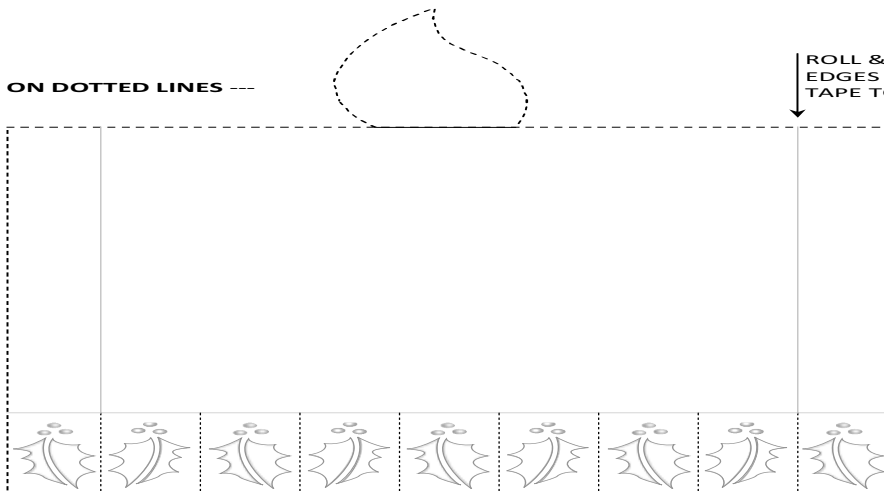

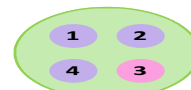

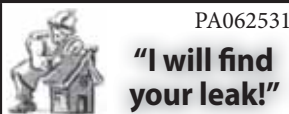
