**Dear Friends:**

**May I wish you a very Blessed Advent Season. It is difficult to believe that the preparation for Christmas has arrived. Where did the Summer go? Was Pope Francis' visit to Philadelphia actually over two months ago? (Please see Fr. Friel for specifics☺) Wasn't it unbelievably warm just a few weeks ago? And yet, here we are again, getting ready- in many ways-for our hearts and souls to welcome the New Born King.**

**A few Parish items and events still need to be caught up on. The October Count was published in the bulletin and forwarded to the Archdiocese. The attendance at Mass has held its own over the past year. While this is a good sign, still we are operating our wonderful parish on the backs of a small percentage of faithful parishioners. We have formed a group called the "New Evangelization Committee." The idea of the group was formed from all the parish meetings last year. St. Anselm parishioners saw a need for such a group, and now it has happened. It will be the goal of the group to enhance the faith of all those included in the October Count. Also, the goal will be to try and increase the number of those who were not included; to search out ways and means to bring some of our parishioners back to Church, and back to their Faith.**

**There are still several copies of "The Little Blue Book" at the entrances of church. As many are aware, these delightful books provide a six minute daily reflection for each day of Advent. The book makes a wonderful companion for your journey towards welcoming the Light of Christ into our minds and hearts at Christmas.**

**For me, being a high school soccer coach for 22 years, the month of November brought back many good memories of soccer. For many years, my teams would get to the playoffs. We would be in the playoffs until we ran into either Archbishop Ryan or Wood. We were able to defeat Wood one year and we reached the semi-finals. To the joy of many reading this article, we were never able to defeat Ryan (except one regular season win in 1999 ). But, I would like to share two soccer stories that I have witnessed here at the parish during November.**

**A few weeks ago, I received a call from the Boys' Soccer team. They said that the team was having its annual game versus their parents. I was invited to participate. I looked around through my "stuff" and found the soccer cleats that I used when I coached. The game started with more than 11 players on a side but no one seemed to mind (except the goaltenders). A wonderful competitive spirit existed on both sides. It was a cool crisp night; however, no one seemed to mind. No one wanted the game to end that Sunday evening but the Eagles' game was on at 8:30. (We should have played soccer longer☺) And so, a big thank you to the Boys' Soccer team, their coach, and parents for the invitation and for including me in the game.**

**The second soccer story involves the Parkwood Youth Organization. The last Saturday and Sunday of November marks the PYO Soccer Tournament. Many teams, players, parents, officials, and CARS. On Saturday morning, we not only had our regular Saturday morning Mass but also a large funeral Mass along with an afternoon wedding. In steps Fr. Friel to the rescue. A few weeks ago, Fr. Friel was invited to a fund-raiser at PYO. While he was there, he "worked" the crowd, in anticipation of the upcoming tournament, and the parking lot problems that it would create at St. Anselm. As a result, on the mornings of the tournament, PYO have several of their folks helping to move the cars around in the parking lot to accommodate both the soccer folks as well as, the people who had come to our church for varied reasons. Thanks to Fr. Friel for being at the fundraiser and thanks to PYO and your hearty volunteers in making the parking situation work.**

**Finally, on Tuesday, December 8, the feast of the Immaculate Conception, the worldwide Church will begin her Jubilee Year, The Year of Mercy. The celebration will begin on December 8, and continue until November 20, 2016. More about our Year of Mercy in next week's bulletin.**

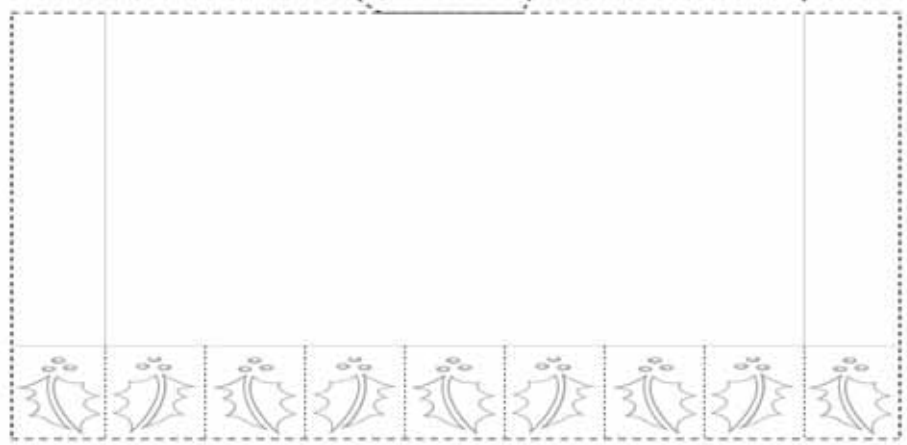
