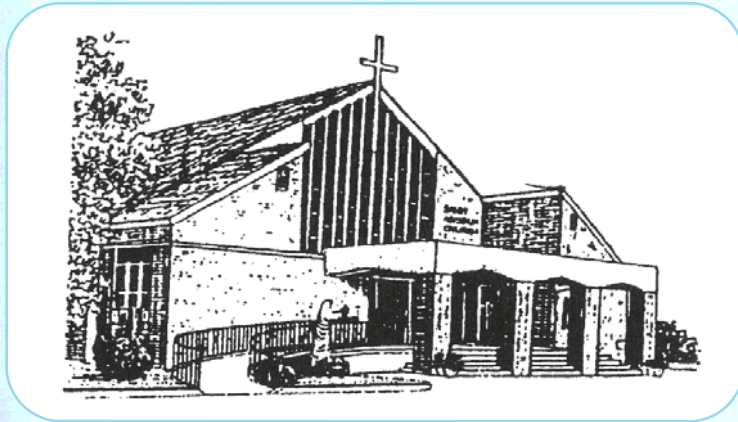

## **A Good Middle of Lent Greeting to You!**

**As our Lenten Season continues to move along, it may be time to reflect on how your Lenten Season is moving along. Have you held onto the promises and resolutions that you made on Ash Wednesday? Have you drifted away from your promises? Have you re-centered yourself, if you have fallen a bit? Whatever the situation, please remember that you still have a few weeks left to either continue—or start anew—with those good things that you could be doing for your own soul or for the souls of others.**

**On Tuesday evening, February 16<sup>th</sup>, in our Spirituality Center, we had the first of our Lenten Adult Formation classes. Talk about: "well-attended!" As the doors opened at 6:40 P.M., a steady flow of parishioners streamed through. By 7:00, there were almost 50 people, who had to bring in chairs from the dining room into the conference room. The topic that evening was: "The Ten Plagues." Never has a discussion on such a frightening topic been presented and received in such an "upbeat" way. Unique perspectives, from both sides, provided for an entertaining and instructional evening. If you missed it, please join us this week. Maybe by the end of Lent, the program will be "BYOC", "bring your own chair."☺**

**Also on February 18<sup>th</sup>, the School Development Committee met for the third time. Remember, that it was less than one year ago that this type of group was suggested by the Parish Assembly. Now, the team is ready to enhance our parish and school communities with outstanding suggestions and recommendations. Also, within the next couple of weeks, an Advancement Director will be hired. Once again, this idea was put forth at the Parish Assembly. We are staying true to the wishes of all our parishioners from the Parish Assembly.**

**Speaking once again about the Parish Assembly, another proposal of the Assembly was the forming of a Parish Evangelization Committee. As has been previously stated in this bulletin, that group is also up and running. Proof of the work of this group was found in last week's Parish Bulletin. The purple insert was envisioned and prepared by the committee along with the auspices and designs of Fr. Friel. We are very excited as a St. Anselm Parish to make these inserts and suggestions available to many parishioners in church and through the mail.**

**Back to "Our Lady of Knots", or better known as "the crosses and knots" for Lent. Once again, many thanks to all who were so patient and kind with the distribution and separating of the crosses and lanyards. Many parishioners have asked what the procedures will be for the crosses at the end of Lent. Many are asking because of the practice of the wood chips being nailed to the cross during Holy Week.**

**It is my plan for the parishioners who received the crosses to bring their crosses and lanyards to church on Good Friday. During the Good Friday service, there will be a large cross on the side altar. The cross will have eight (8) large nails struck through it. As you venerate the Cross in the center aisle, you can then move to the cross with the nails in it. You can give your lanyard to a member of the Evangelization Committee, who will then hang your cross and lanyard on the nails. The lanyards and crosses will hang there as a reminder of what you tried to accomplish during your Lenten journey. I hope this makes sense, as we try something new this year.**

**May God continue to bless you and your families as we move through our Lenten Season of 2016.**
