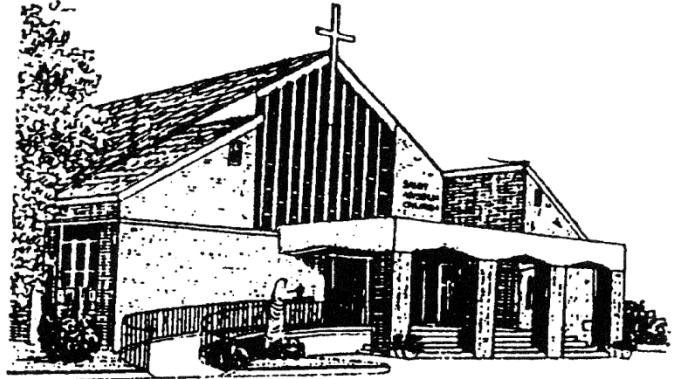

BAPTISMS

Baptisms are every Sunday at 1:00 PM. Parents are asked to call the Parish Center and speak with the Priest or Deacon who is on call and who will assist them in registering their child for Baptism. The Church assists the parents by offering instruction on the meaning, importance, and responsibilities of the sacrament of Baptism. A Pre-Jordan Baptismal Program for helping parents prepare for the spiritual birth of their child is held on the fourth Sunday of most months in the Spirituality Center following the Noon Mass.

The everyday routine of the daily morning Mass is becoming my “new normal.” Being able to meet some of the families, for whom the Mass is being offered for their loved ones, is valuable for me to continue my promise of always honoring and respecting the past and foundations of St. Anselm Parish.

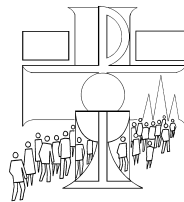
Perhaps the most remarkable occurrences of my first month as Pastor has been in celebrating several funeral Masses. Obviously, I have never had a chance to meet the souls who have died. I have spoken with the families of the deceased before the Mass. I have been amazed as to how much of a connection I would have had with those persons, if I had known them while they were parishioners. The correlation with their lives and their experiences that tie in closely with my life are incredible. For instance, last week I celebrated the Funeral Mass for Patricia Domanico. Several months ago, her husband passed away. I found out from Patricia’s family, that she and her husband operated a small deli in Mayfair—called “Domanico’s Deli.” When I asked Patricia’s daughter where the deli was located, it seems that it was the same deli that we used to call “Sid’s” when we were growing up. When I was in grade school at St. Bernard’s, I would go there at lunch time for bread and lunch meat. Also, when my mom was expecting me in the hot summer of 1955, she would send my sisters to Sid’s for a root beer water ice—extra root beer, please 😊

So many connections this past month. I believe that they are God’s way of introducing me to the fantastic parishioners that have always made St. Anselm a wonderful parish for many years. As our summer progresses, let us thank the Lord for all his blessings to our parish, especially our parishioners who have died. We thank them for leaving us with such a great spirit and a rock solid foundation for us to stand and build on.
