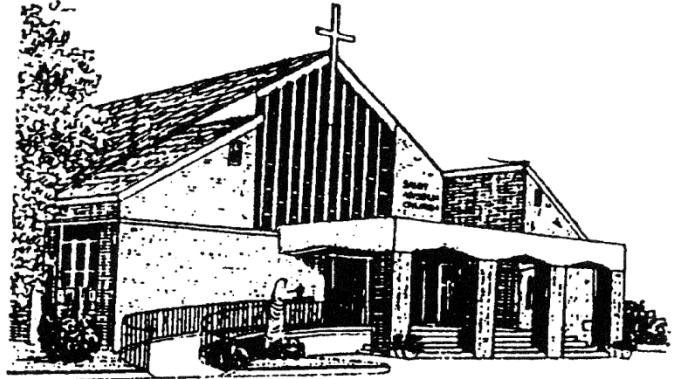

BAPTISMS

The Church assists the parents by offering instruction on the meaning, importance, and responsibilities of the sacrament of Baptism. A Pre-Jordan Baptismal Program for helping parents prepare for the spiritual birth of their child is held on the fourth Sunday of most months in the Spirituality Center following the Noon Mass.

As he walked up a set of stairs, he was told that this is where his office is located. Outside of his office was a huge portrait of Red Auerbach. Red was a successful coach, General Manager, and executive of the Celtics. His portrait consisted of Red, smoking his famous "victory cigar," with the many, many Celtics' championship banners behind him. Seeing that portrait, just outside of his office, Brad Stevens was moved to say: "No pressure there!"

Last week, our St. Anselm teachers returned for their opening workshop and Mass. I shared some thoughts with them about me being their new pastor as they prepared for the upcoming school year. I also shared the above story with them. As we gathered in the Spirituality Center, I asked them to turn around and look at the table in the back of the room. On the table sat a portrait of Fr. Dunleavy. Everyone laughed, as I echoed the words of Brad Stevens: "No pressure there."☺

The beauty of this is how the gift of the priesthood has been a wonderful part of St. Anselm Parish, since the beginning. Priests have come and gone here for over 50 years. And each one has been welcomed by our loving and accepting parishioners. In fact, just this week, I have been in contact with Fr. Dunleavy, had dinner with Fr. Chylinski, and sent an invitation for my installation to Msgr. Shields. I am blessed to stand on the shoulders of the many priests who have had the privilege of serving St. Anselm Parish over the years. No pressure here; just an honor and a pleasure.

Please continue to talk up our great Parish and School wherever you go.
