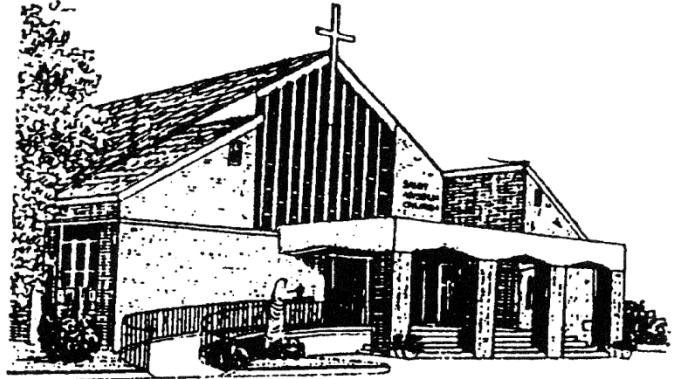

BAPTISMS

By all accounts, everything went just great. Also, last week, a parishioner called and wanted to help our school students with a generous donation. The parishioner was very humble and caring with her gift; a gift for which we, as a parish community, are most grateful. Two weeks ago, a parishioner stopped by the Parish Center to donate two portraits commemorating Pope Francis' visit to Philadelphia. The portraits, now on display in church, and in the center, were painted by local artist Perry Milou. The next day, a full article appeared about the artist, and his portraits, in the newspaper.

Last week, another parishioner wanted to share her plaque of "Mary, the Undoer of Knots." It is a favorite devotion of Pope Francis. The plaque, along with the Pope's portrait, is on display in the back of church, near the confessionals. More about this devotion will follow. On Friday evening of last week, September 11th, there was a Patriotic Concert, promoted by our own Father Friel. Father graced us with his wonderful music talents, joined by our cantor Jeff Kearns. We are blessed as a country; and most certainly, as a parish- as we honor the memory and heroism of many on that fateful day in 2001.

This week, we have been honored to welcome Bishop Michael J. Fitzgerald to our St. Anselm Parish. The bishop, representing Archbishop Chaput, installed me as your new pastor. I am most blessed and humbled.

Finally, on Tuesday of this past week, we welcomed back our students to school. It was the first time for me as pastor to experience this honor. As the students came in, from First Grade to Eighth Grade, they each entered with different degrees of eagerness. One delightful exchange occurred when a Second Grader entered the school, took two big steps into the building, and declared: "Yes, I'm in Second Grade!" May that enthusiasm continue in our school and in our parish. It is indeed the most wonderful time of the year.
