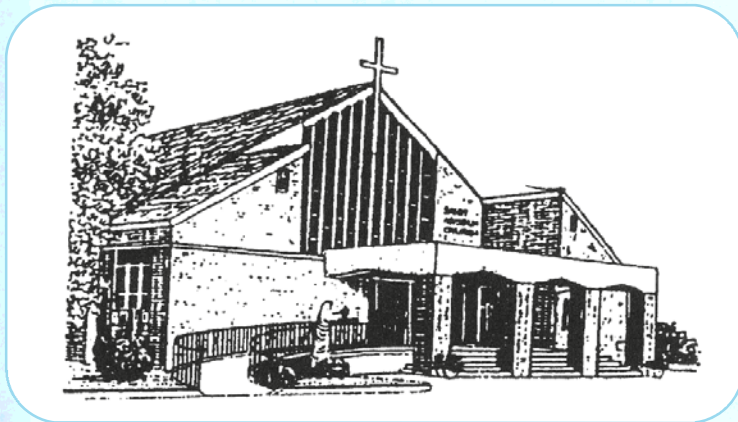

As we swiftly run through this month of October, we are again reminded that it is the month of the Holy Rosary. Thank you to Mrs. Kowalski, President of our Home and School Association and the entire Board for their dedication and work for our school and students.

A thank you to Our Ladies of St. Anselm on their recent trip to New York. Not only were our devoted ladies treated to a wonderful meal and show; but, their overflow of funds was generously donated back to our parish. We once again are blessed to have such a faithful group of parishioners and supporters who are always thinking of St. Anselm Parish. Thank you.

Over the past few weeks and months, there have been many improvements made to the physical grounds of our parish. As was previously mentioned, there was, and continues to be, concrete work and patching done along Belgreen and Dunks Ferry Roads. All this is necessary before the winter time. Also, you may have noticed the area behind the Rectory and Spirituality Center looks a bit more open. We had roughly 10 trees removed. These trees were essentially dead and posed a danger to those walking or driving near this area and our Prayer Garden. Once again, the snows of winter would have greatly exaggerated the problems caused by the decayed limbs and barks. Building & Grounds \$ working hard!

As mentioned previously, it is a fine and appropriate time to give homage to Mary, through the recitation of the rosary, especially during the month of October. Thanks to all who organized, led, and participated in the rosary that evening.
