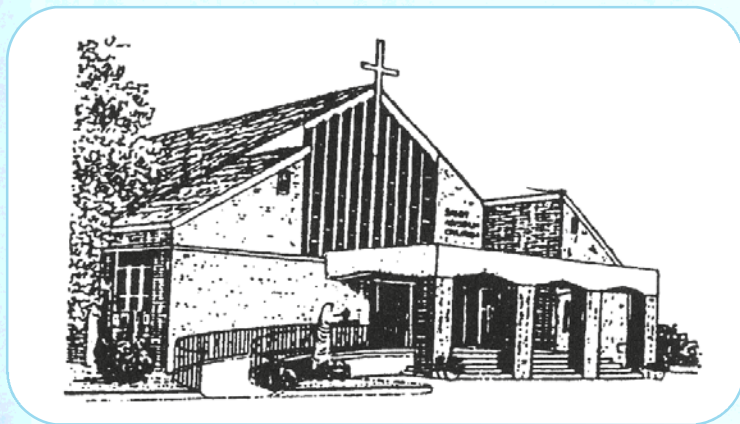

A middle of the Autumnal season greeting to you:

I can't use the word "autumnal" enough...As the month of October begins to wind down, we continue to remember that it is the month of the Holy Rosary. May Our Blessed Mother continue to watch over us. The month of October contains many significant and important feasts days and remembrances. The month includes: St. Therese of the Child Jesus (The Little Flower), Oct. 1; The Guardian Angel, Oct.2; St. Francis of Assisi, Oct. 4; Our Lady of the Rosary, Oct. 7; St. Callistus, Oct. 14 (buy me a cup of coffee and I'll tell you why I included him...); St. Luke, Oct. 18; St. John of Capistrano, Oct. 23, (cup of coffee); and Saints Simon and Jude, Oct. 28. What a rich and wonderful faith tradition we have!

A few things to catch-up on...Towards the end of September, we celebrated our school Mass installing the officers for the 2018-2019 school year. Our elected and selected school students are our Student Council Officers (elected members of our 8th Grade). We are blessed again, here at St. Anselm School, to have a wonderful 8th Grade. As an example of just how awesome our 8th Grade is, there were students who ran for the grade positions of Student Council last May. Those who were not elected to their desired positions continued to help and volunteer for their fellow students, immediately. All of our 8th Graders TTT; WTW, i.e. Talk the Talk; Walk the Walk. Other installed officers and volunteers consist of: Homeroom Representatives, Safety Patrol, Peer Helpers, Ambassadors, and Altar Server Officers. It is yet another example of the quality education that our students learn and live out every day.

During these past couple of weeks I have been involved with our preparation for the reception of the Sacrament of Confirmation on Wednesday, November 7. This involvement includes the arranging of the hymns and readings for the Mass, as well as the liturgical practices and reviews for our Confirmandi, i.e. the formal term for those preparing to receive their Confirmation. I have been with our 6th graders at the singing practices in church, right after lunch on most days. I have also been with our Prep students on Sunday mornings, reviewing their questions for Bishop Martino, as well as going over course materials. Both groups will represent our St. Anselm Parish well on the day of their Confirmation. Thanks to all whose influence is very apparent in the cooperation and preparation of our students.

Over the course of many days and weeks, we, at the Parish Center, are made aware of those who are sick and ill at home, in the hospital, or in nursing facilities. We are grateful to the families and caretakers who include the names of their loved ones in our bulletin, Sunday intercessions, and in their hearts. There are many folks who are shut-in, who are visited by our dedicated Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion. Many long-time friendships have been cultivated there. We are thankful to our deacons and Fr. Murphy who, always so dedicated, bring the Holy Eucharist to those who cannot get to church. And our visits to the hospitals and nursing facilities are always an indication of complying with the Corporal and Spiritual Works of Mercy. Should there be someone that you know or care for, and they are not on our Communion Call list, or perhaps someone who is in the hospital or nursing facility, please do not hesitate to call the Parish Center and we will know what to do from there.
