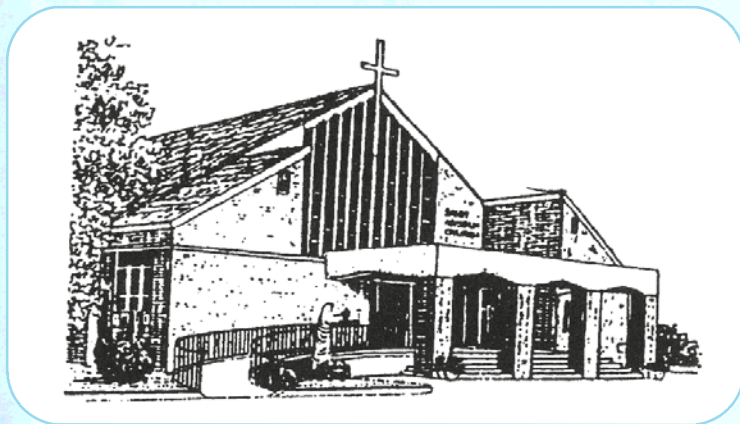

PROPERTY TAX REBATE

To help with the rising cost of living, you are reminded that Pennsylvania Property Tax/Rent Rebate Program applications are now available. There are new guidelines which will permit individuals that qualify to receive rebate between \$250 and \$650 from property taxes or rent paid last year. Funding for this rebate program is made possible by the Pennsylvania State Lottery Fund and is a rebate that does not have to be repaid. This application must be filed by December 31, 2018.

To qualify, you must be 65 years of age or older, a widow or widower 50 years of age or older, or a disabled person 18 years or older. Homeowners that have annual incomes of \$35,000 or less and renters with annual incomes of \$15,000 or less could qualify. Only half of your annual Social Security or SSI income is counted toward the income guideline.

For more information or an application, call United Social Services, Monday through Friday between 10 AM and 4 PM at 215-923-1900 and a staff member will assist you.

FACTS Grant and Aid

- Cost to apply is \$30

FACTS Grant & Aid Assessment will be conducting the financial need analysis for the Archdiocese of Philadelphia (BLOCS and the Foundation for Catholic Education) to St. Anselm School for the upcoming 2019-2020 school year. Families applying for financial aid will need to complete an application and submit the necessary supporting documentation to FACTS Grant & Aid Assessment. New this year...you will need to submit your 2017 tax returns with your application rather than waiting for your 2018 tax information. Your child must be registered in school for 2019-2020 to qualify for financial aid.
