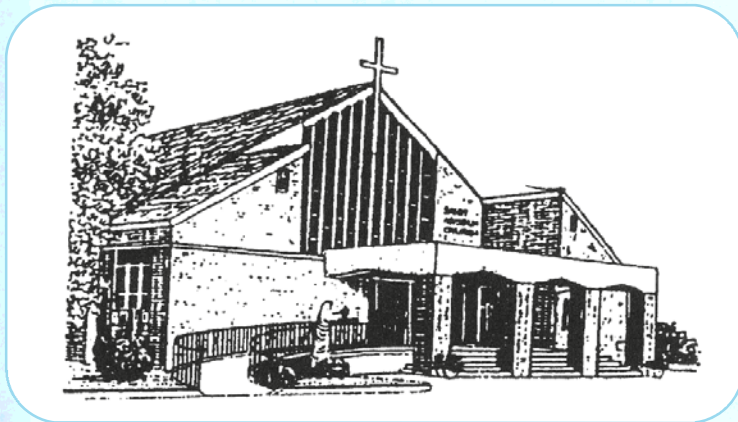

Happy Mid-January; and the beginning of Ordinary Time:

A little change of pace for this bulletin... A few weeks ago, our Deacon Warner delivered a sermon that was well received by many. I think the publication of his homily is in order:

Did any of us ever look at something and not really see it for what it was? Can Christmas be one of them? We know that Christmas is the birth of Jesus Christ. Now, do we see that or do we just see the decorations and presents. Or is it that the decorations and presents prevent us from seeing Christmas as the birth of Jesus Christ? I think you'll find this interesting.

The Pink Dress

There was this little girl sitting by herself in the park. Everyone passed by her and never stopped to see why she looked so sad. Dressed in a worn pink dress, barefoot and dirty, the girl just sat and watched the people go by. She never tried to speak. She never said a word. Many people passed by her, but no one would stop. The next day I decided to go back to the park in curiosity to see if the little girl would still be there. Yes, she was there, right in the very spot where she was yesterday, and still with the same sad look in her eyes. Today I was to make my own move and walk over to the little girl. For as we all know, a park full of strange people is not a place for young children to play alone. As I got closer I could see the back of the little girl's dress. It was grotesquely shaped. I figured that was the reason people just passed by and made no effort to speak to her. Deformities are a low blow to our society and, heaven forbid if you make a step toward assisting someone who is different.

As I got closer, the little girl lowered her eyes slightly to avoid my intent stare. As I approached her, I could see the shape of her back more clearly. She was grotesquely shaped in a humped over form. I smiled to let her know it was OK; I was there to help, to talk. I sat down beside her and opened with a simple, "Hello!" The little girl acted shocked, and stammered a "Hi"; after a long stare into my eyes.

I smiled and she shyly smiled back. We talked until darkness fell and the park was completely empty. I asked the girl why she was so sad. The little girl looked at me with a sad face said, "Because I'm different." I immediately said, "That you are!" And smiled. The little girl acted even sadder and said, "I know." "Little girl," I said, "You remind me of an angel, sweet and innocent." She looked at me and smiled, and then slowly she got to her feet and said, "Really?" "Yes, you're like a little Guardian Angel sent to watch over all the people walking by." She nodded her head yes, and smiled. With that she opened the back of her pink dress and allowed her wings to spread, then she said "I am, I'm your Guardian Angel," with a twinkle in her eye. I was speechless, sure I was seeing things. She said, "For once, you stopped to see something for what it truly was. My job here is done." I got to my feet and said, "Wait, why did no one stop to help an Angel?" She looked at me, smiled, and said, "You're the only one that could see me," and then she was gone. And with that, my life was changed dramatically.

Jesus changes our lives dramatically if we let him. Look at what he did for Mary and Elizabeth. We are all waiting for and looking forward to the celebration of Christmas and rightfully so. In our Gospel Mary and Elizabeth were also waiting and looking forward to the births of Jesus and John the Baptist. On this last Sunday before Christmas our thoughts turn to Mary as she carried Jesus in her womb.

When Mary spoke, the Holy Spirit came on Elizabeth and John the Baptist in Elizabeth's womb. St. Louis Marie de Montfort, who wrote much about Mary, tells us that when we have Mary we will also have the Holy Spirit:

"When the Holy Spirit finds Mary in a soul, he flies to that soul, to communicate himself to it, to fill it with his presence in proportion as he discovers there the presence and the fullness of Mary. "So when we have Mary in our lives we will also have the Holy Spirit, just as the Holy Spirit fell on Elizabeth and John the Baptist when Mary spoke. So we can say that the closer we are to Mary the closer we are to the Holy Spirit, and the closer we are to God. So, may we spend time in prayer this last Sunday before Christmas with Mary that she may implant her roots in our souls, so we can see things for what they really are, and not walk by Christmas and not notice it for what it really is, the birth of Jesus Christ.

New this year...you will need to submit your 2017 tax returns with your application rather than waiting for your 2018 tax information. Your child must be registered in school for 2019-2020 to qualify for financial aid.
