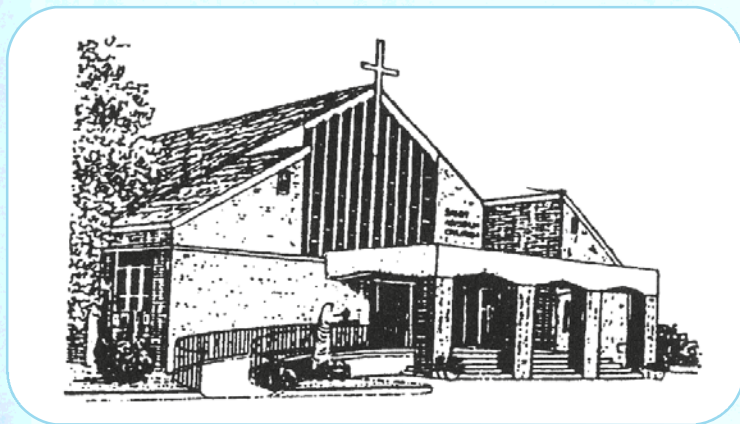

**A beginning of the month of March greeting to you:**

**Where has the time gone since we celebrated Christmas? And now, we are starting our annual Forty Hours Devotions to be followed on Wednesday with the beginning of our Lenten Season. The wonderful thing is that God is all around us! Another reminder of the many ways that He is present to us 24/7, 365 days a year. In fact, God is the first being to claim 24/7, with the dawn of Creation. As we know, everything else followed from that.**

**Some friendly Lenten reminders:**

**+ *FASTING* +**

**Fasting and external penitential practices are accompanied by an inner attitude of conversion. One goes without food and applies physical discipline to “chastise one’s own soul” (Lev. 16:31), to humble oneself before God (Dan. 9:3) and/or to prepare oneself for an encounter with God.**

**The Church urges all Catholics to voluntarily choose acts of penance on all days of Lent. The minimal obligations are:**

**Ash Wednesday & Good Friday: days of fast and abstinence**

**Fridays in Lent: days of abstinence**

**Fasting: all Catholics over 18 years and under 59 years**

**Abstinence: all over 14 years**
